Engagement

Engagement is the degree to which a student invests time and motivation in their college experience. **Engagement is associated with student success.** The NSSE measures student engagement in a variety of areas. The NSSE takes an asset-based approach to measuring engagement in that it focuses on student perspectives about **what ISU can do** to help them be successful.

Dimensions of engagement

Behavioral engagement refers to what students do. This includes their investment of time, energy and resources to college-related activities and experiences.

Emotional engagement refers to positive or negative affective responses to college experiences.

Cognitive engagement is about the time, energy and resources directed towards complex concepts and acquisition of skills.

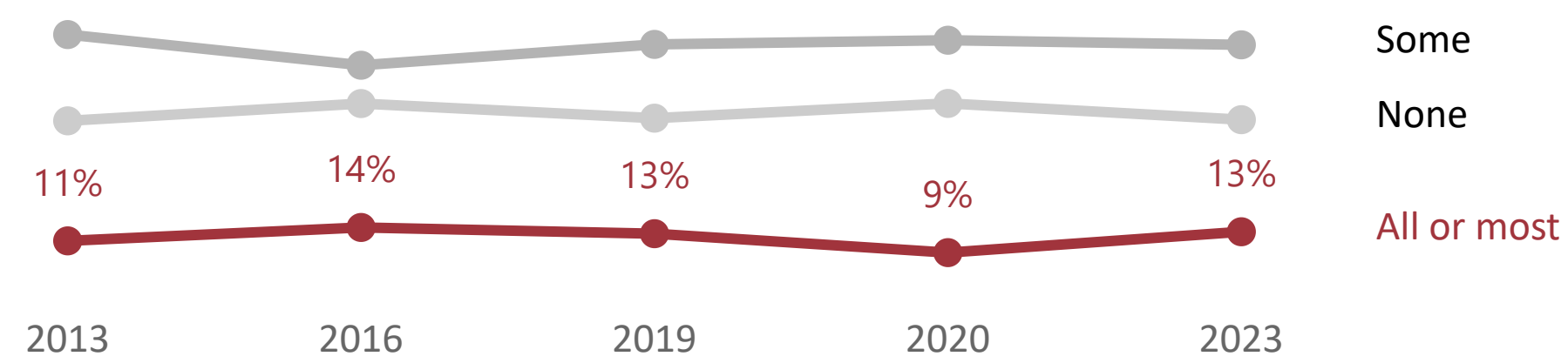

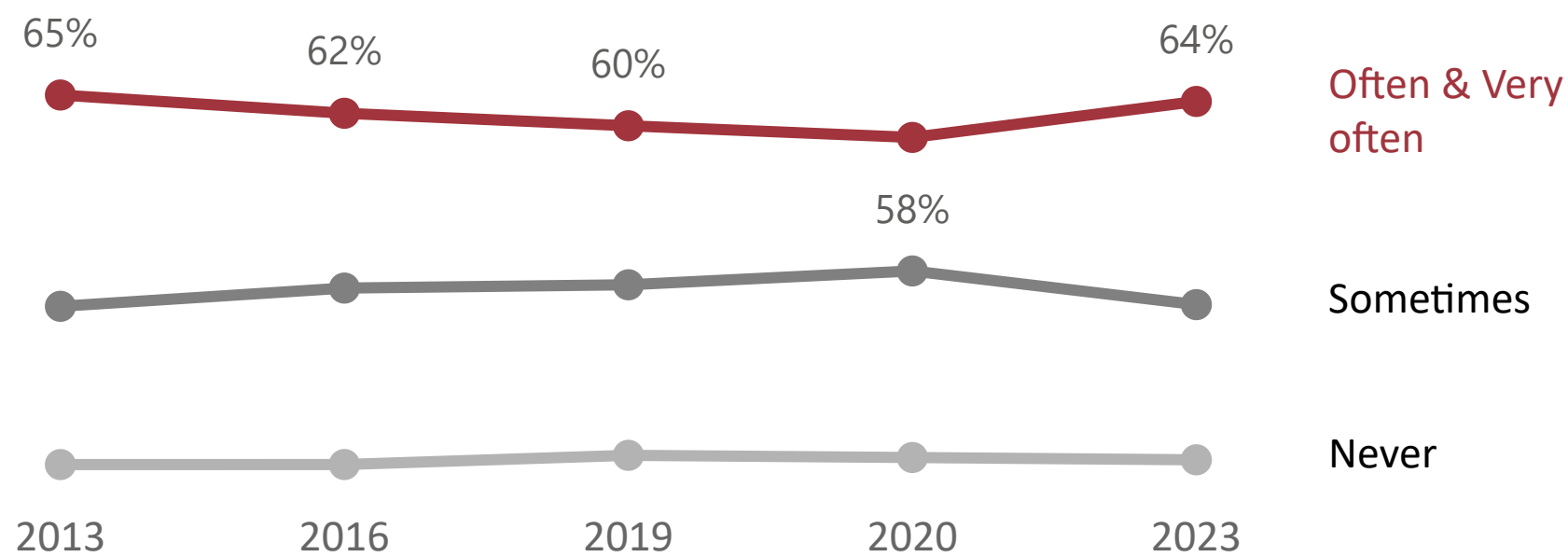

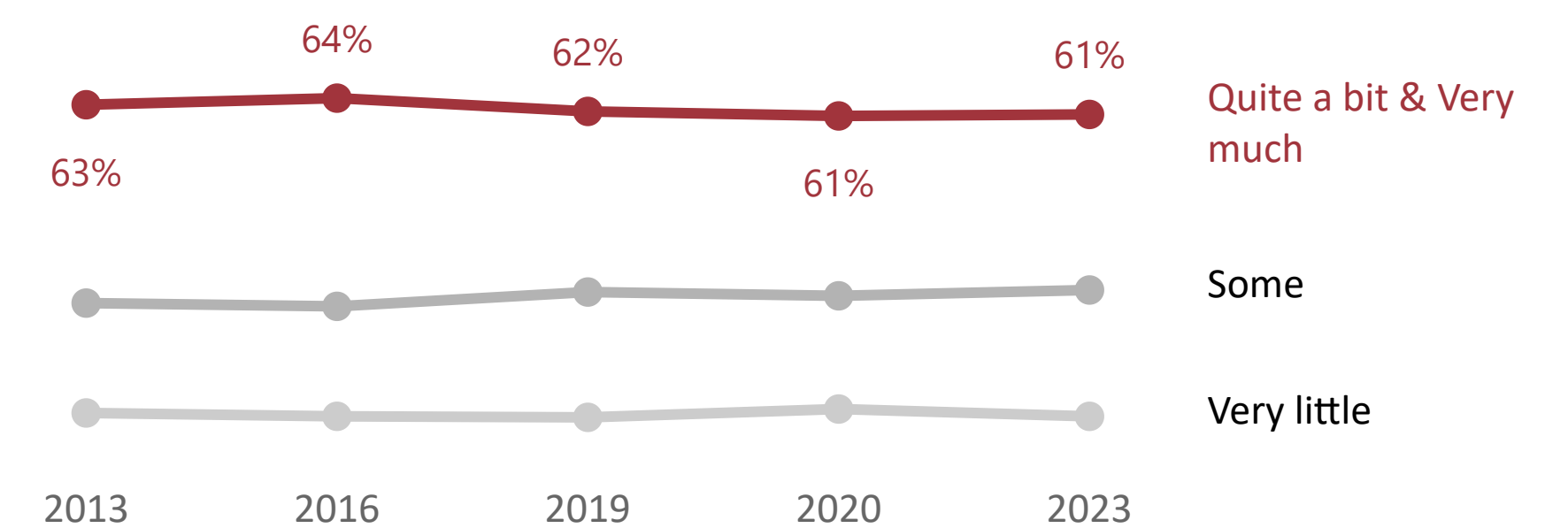

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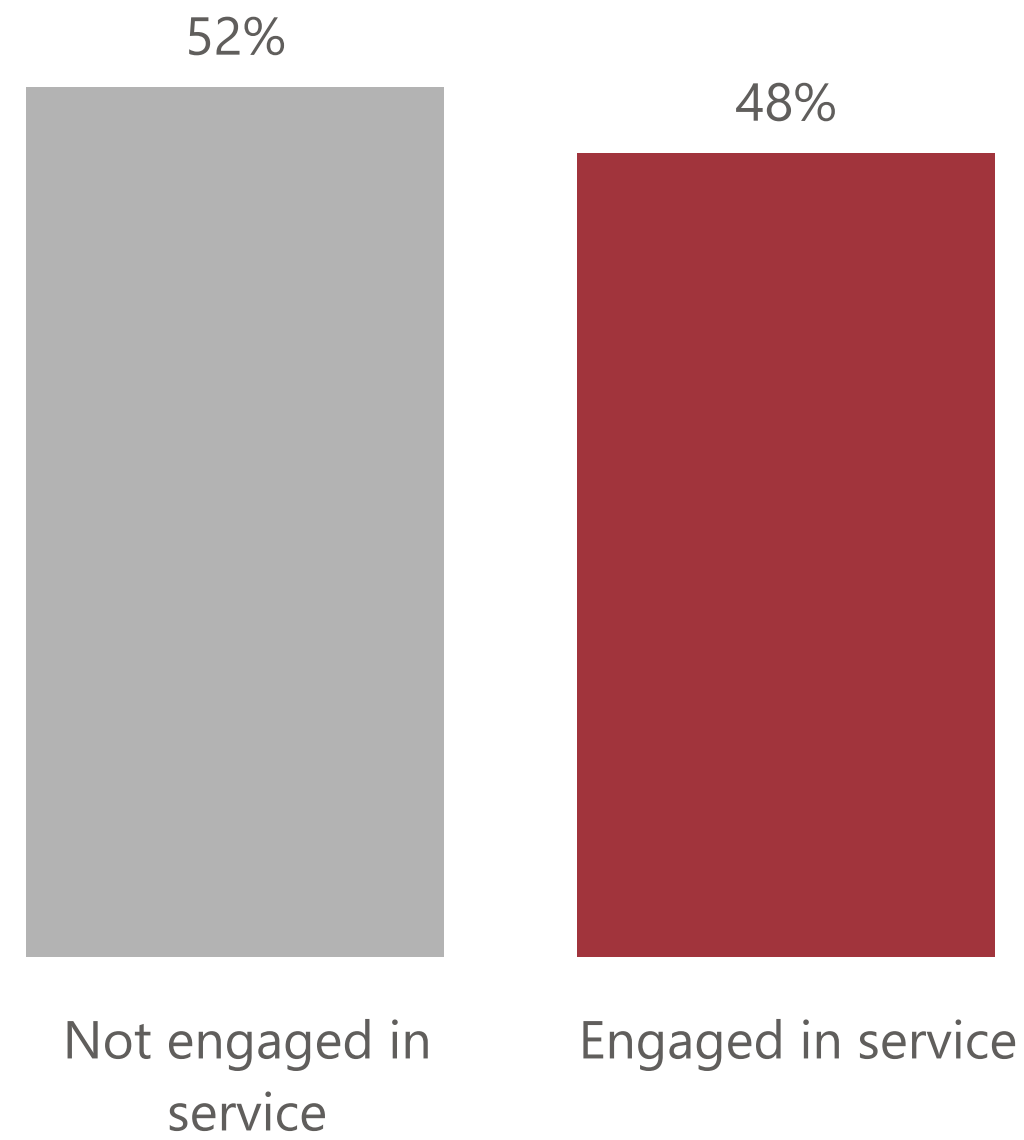

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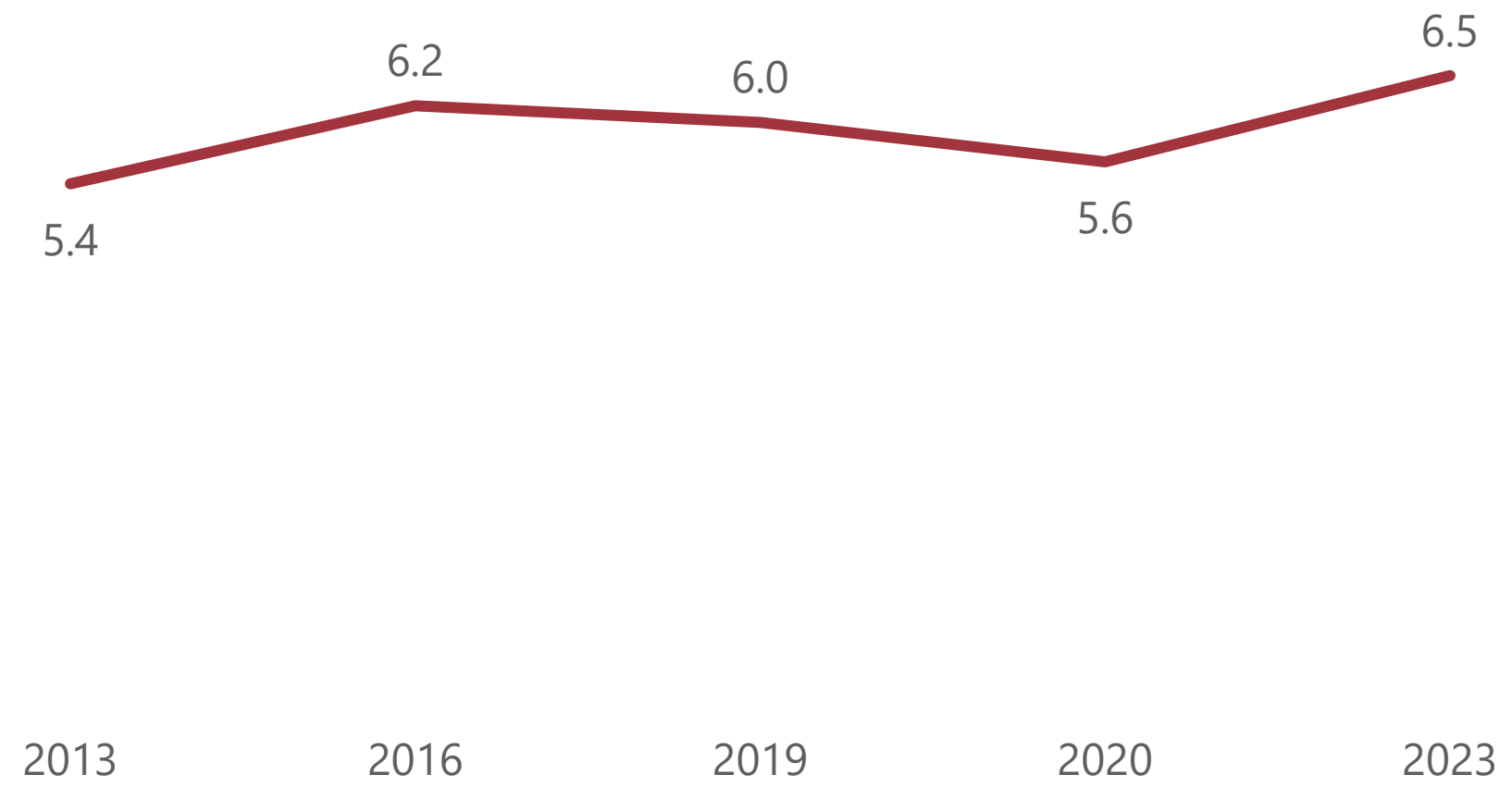

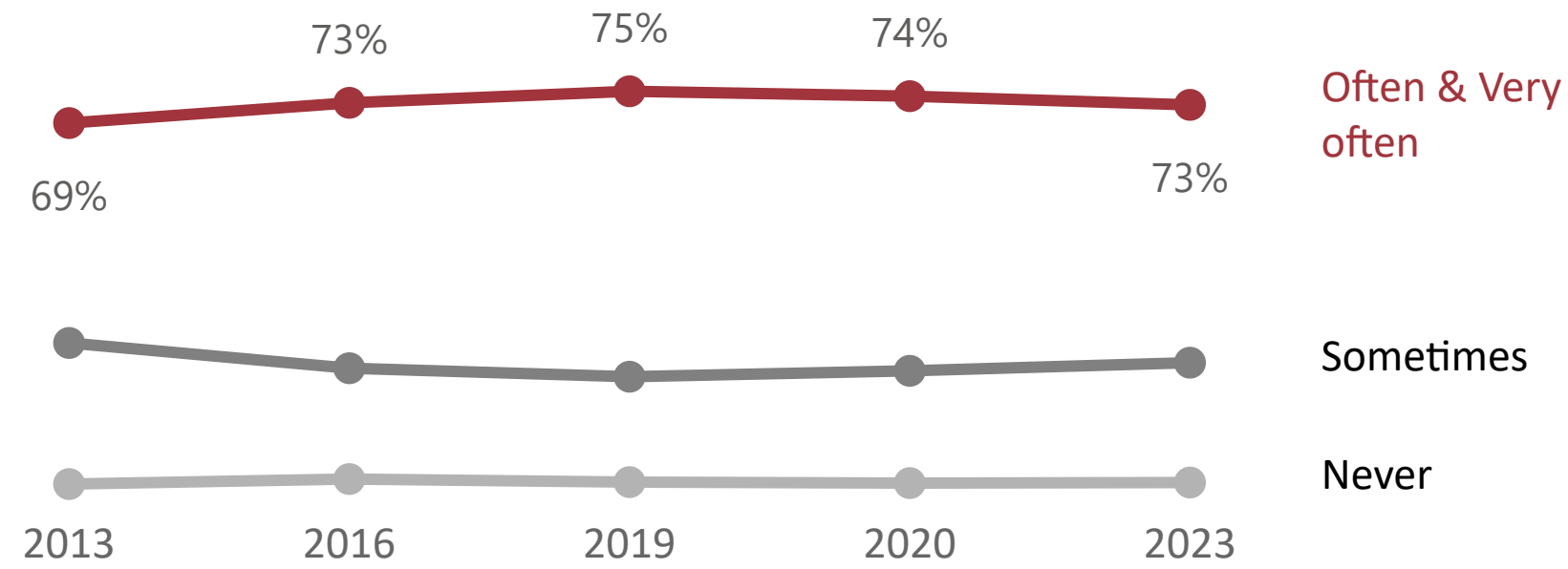

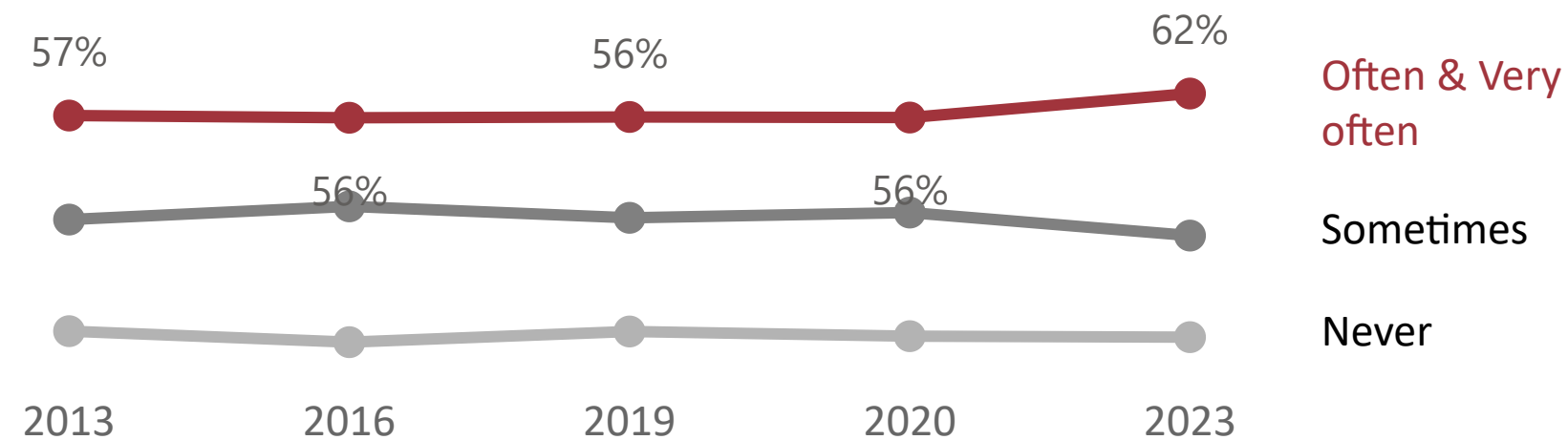

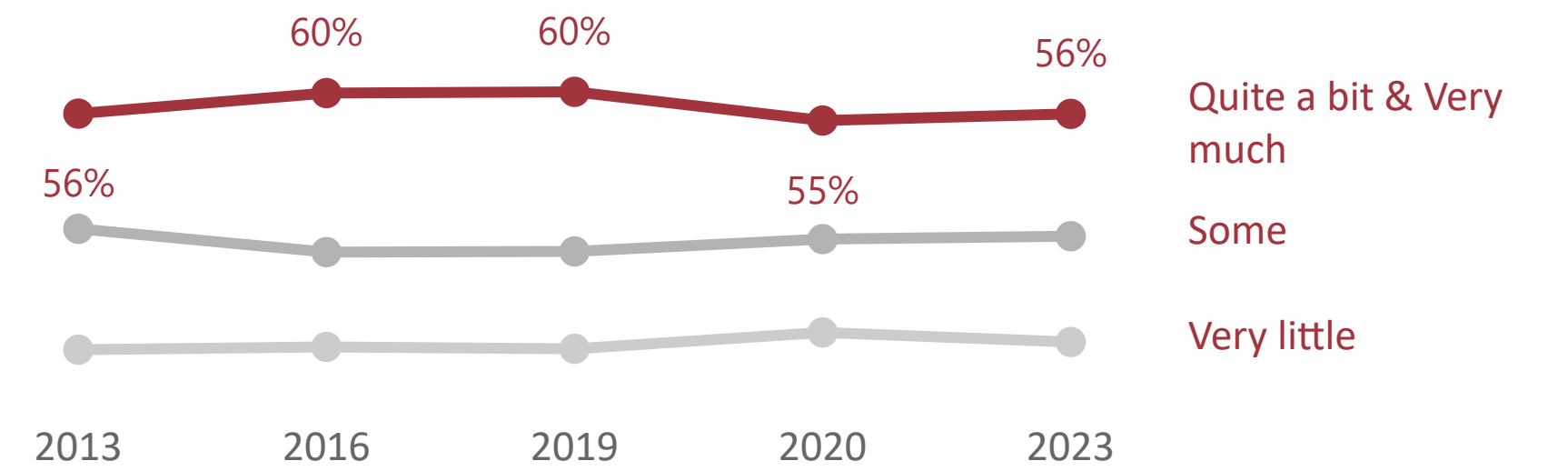

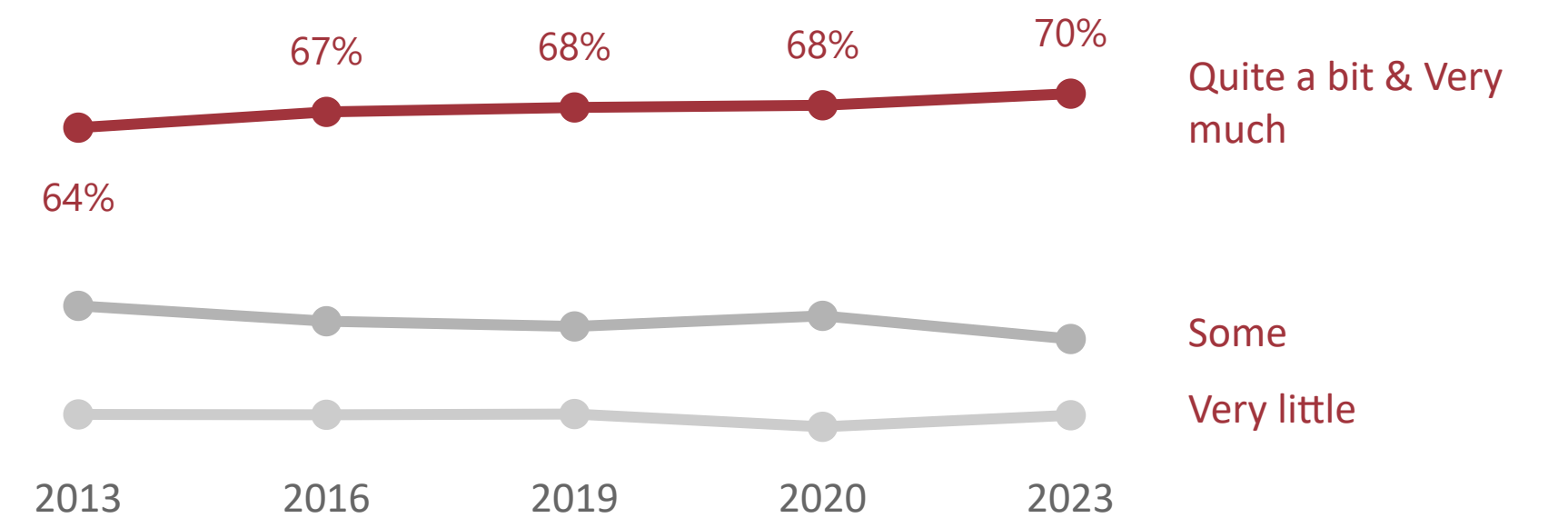

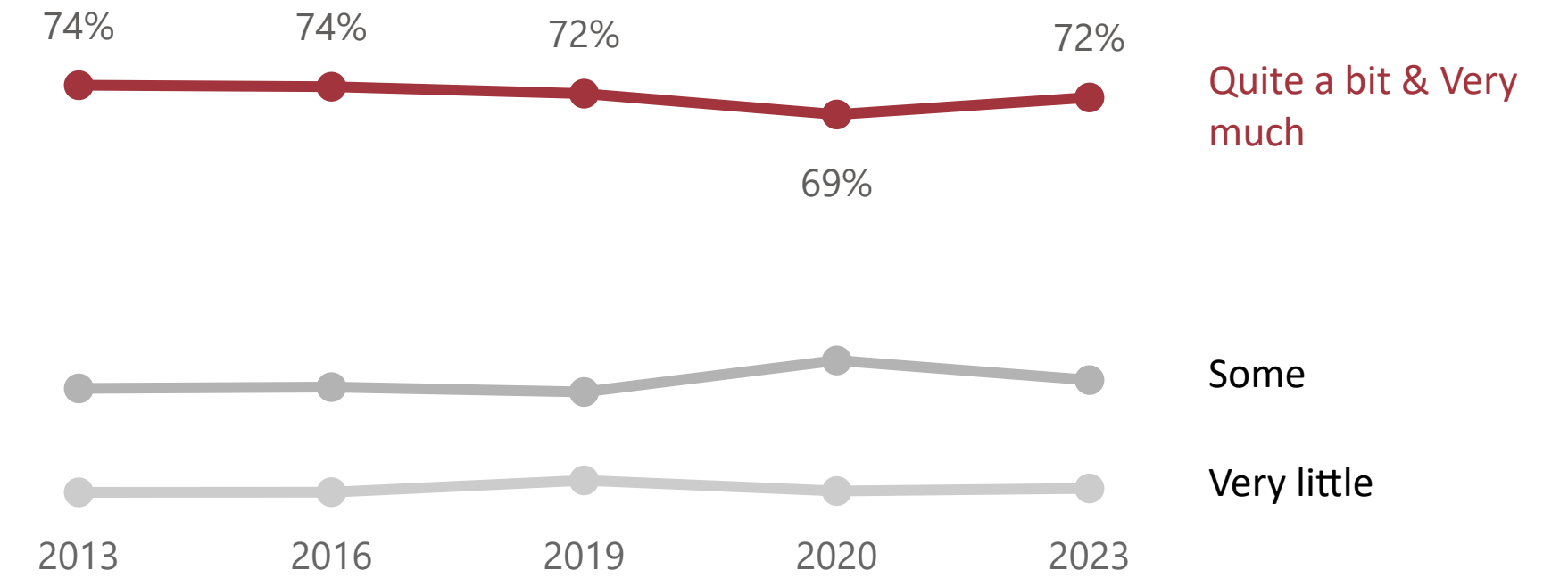

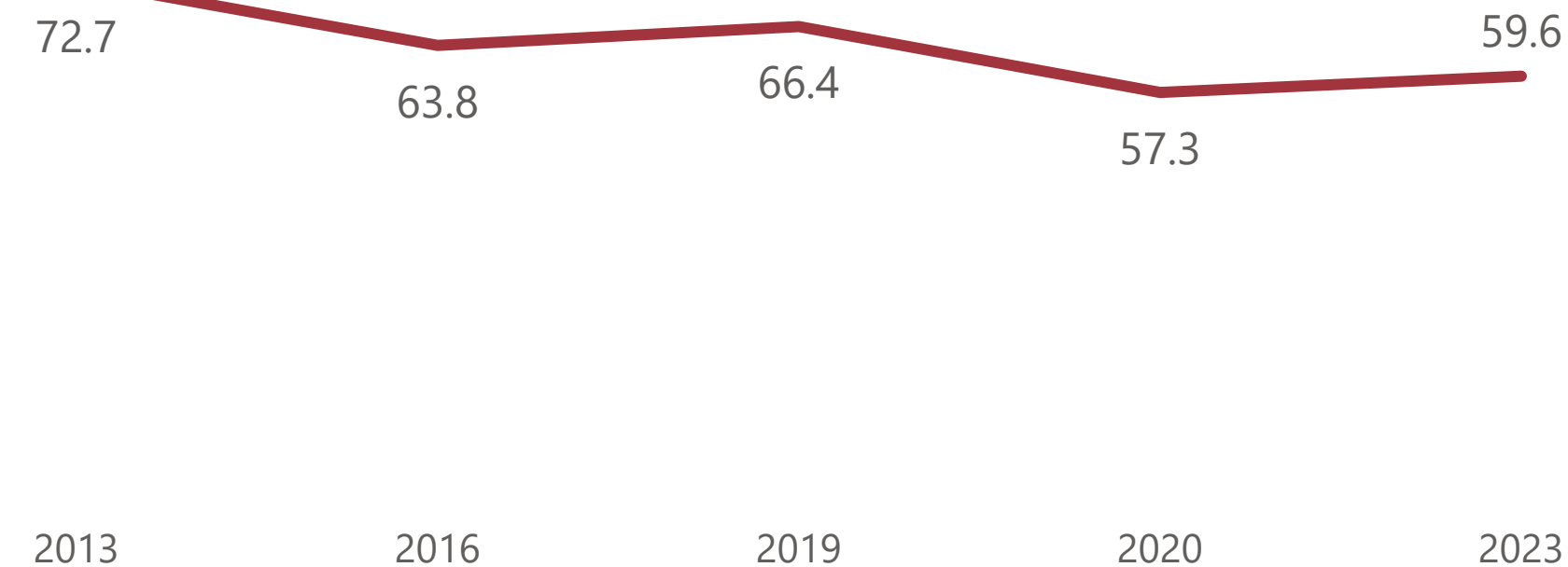

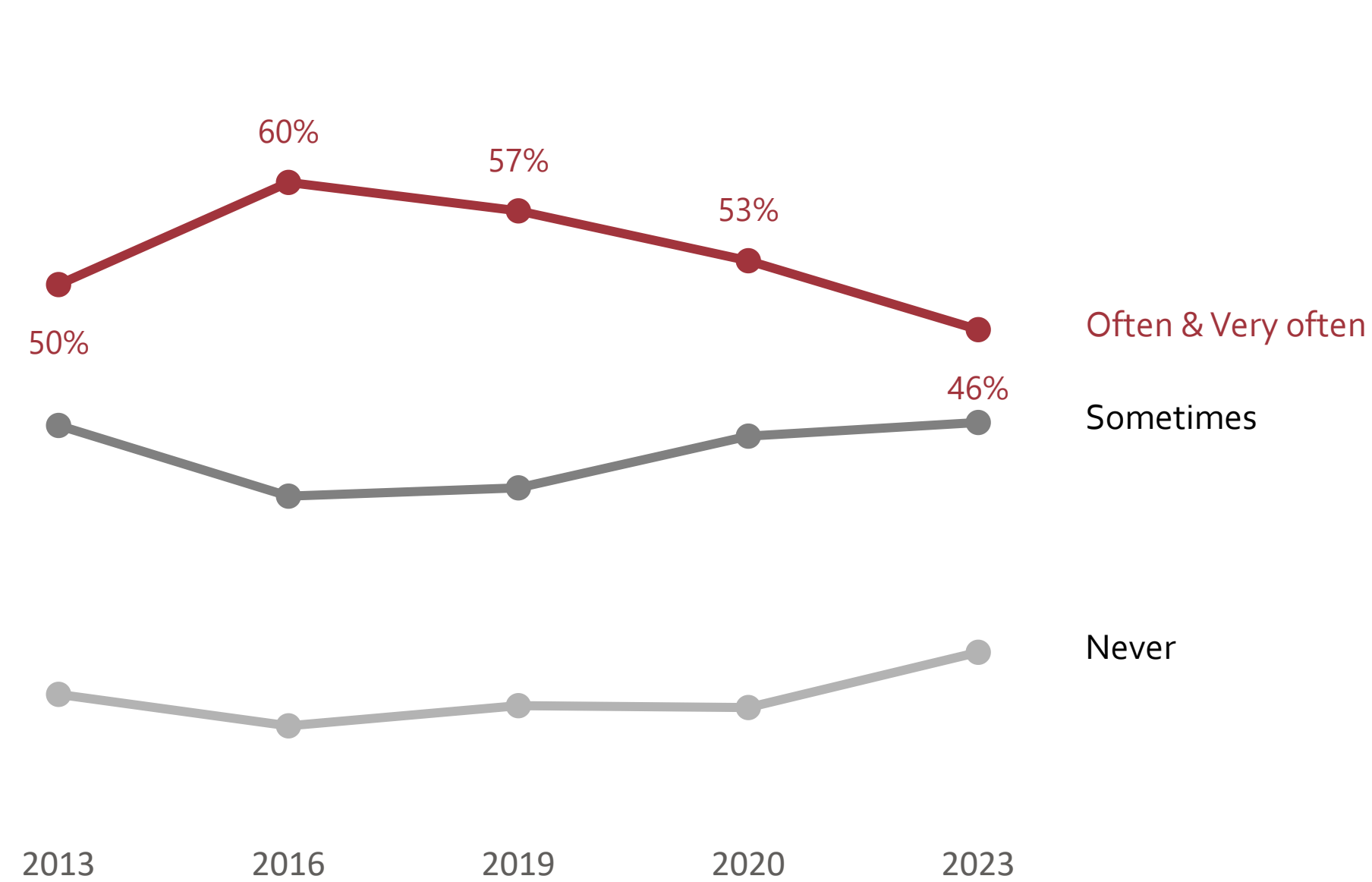

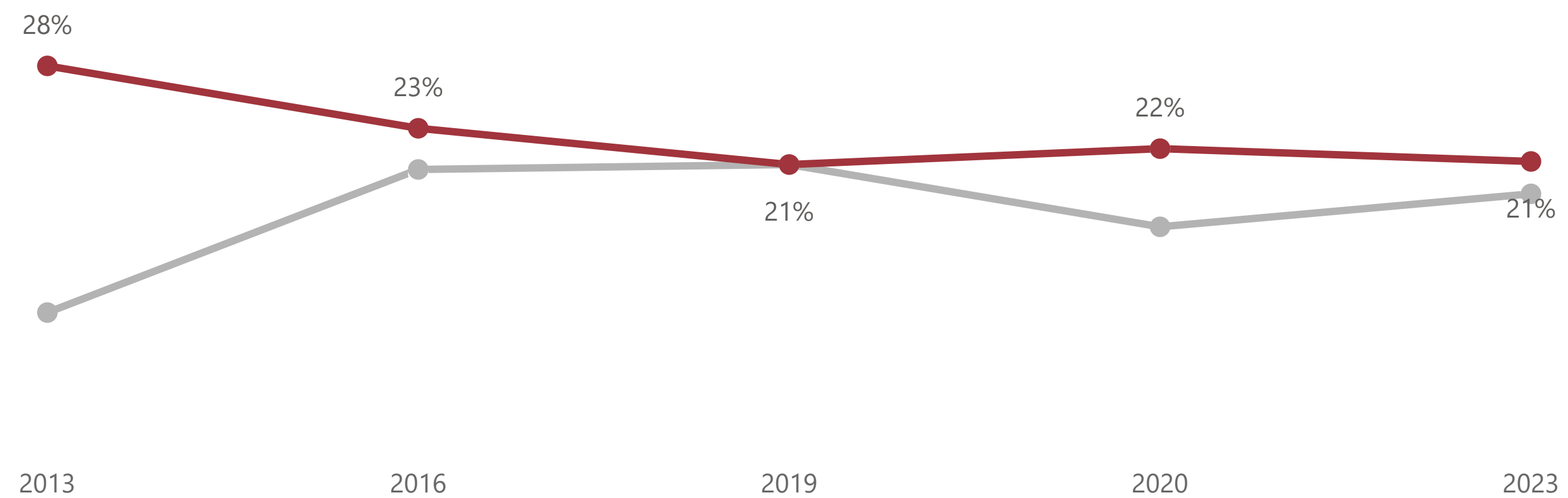

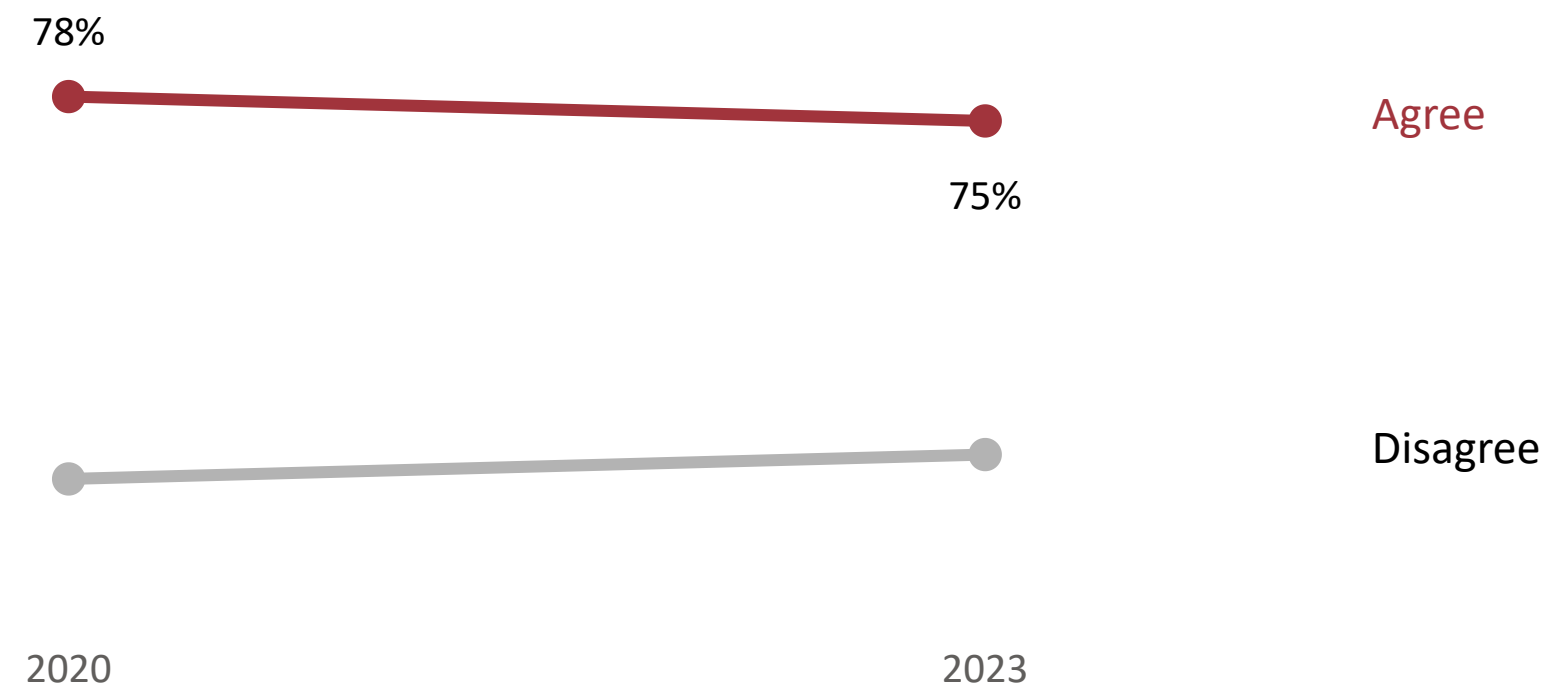

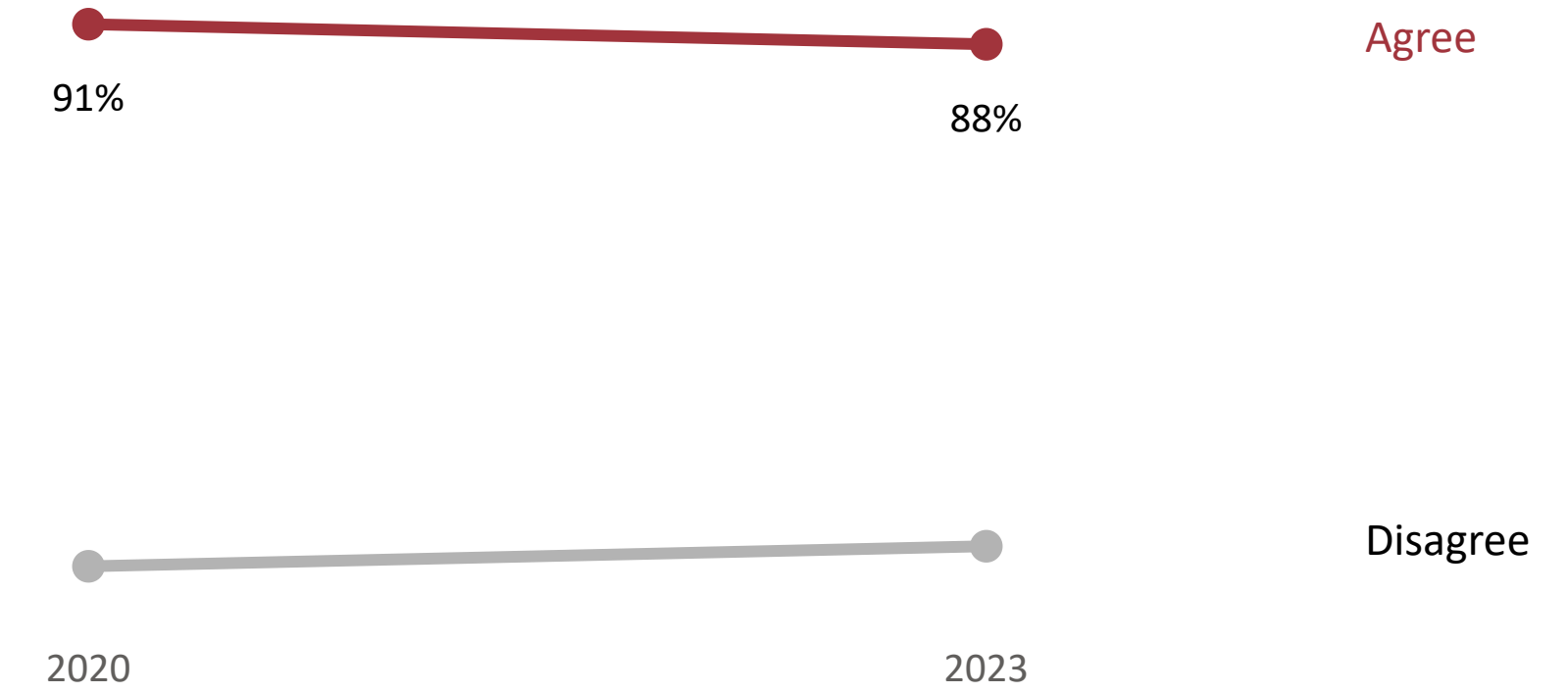

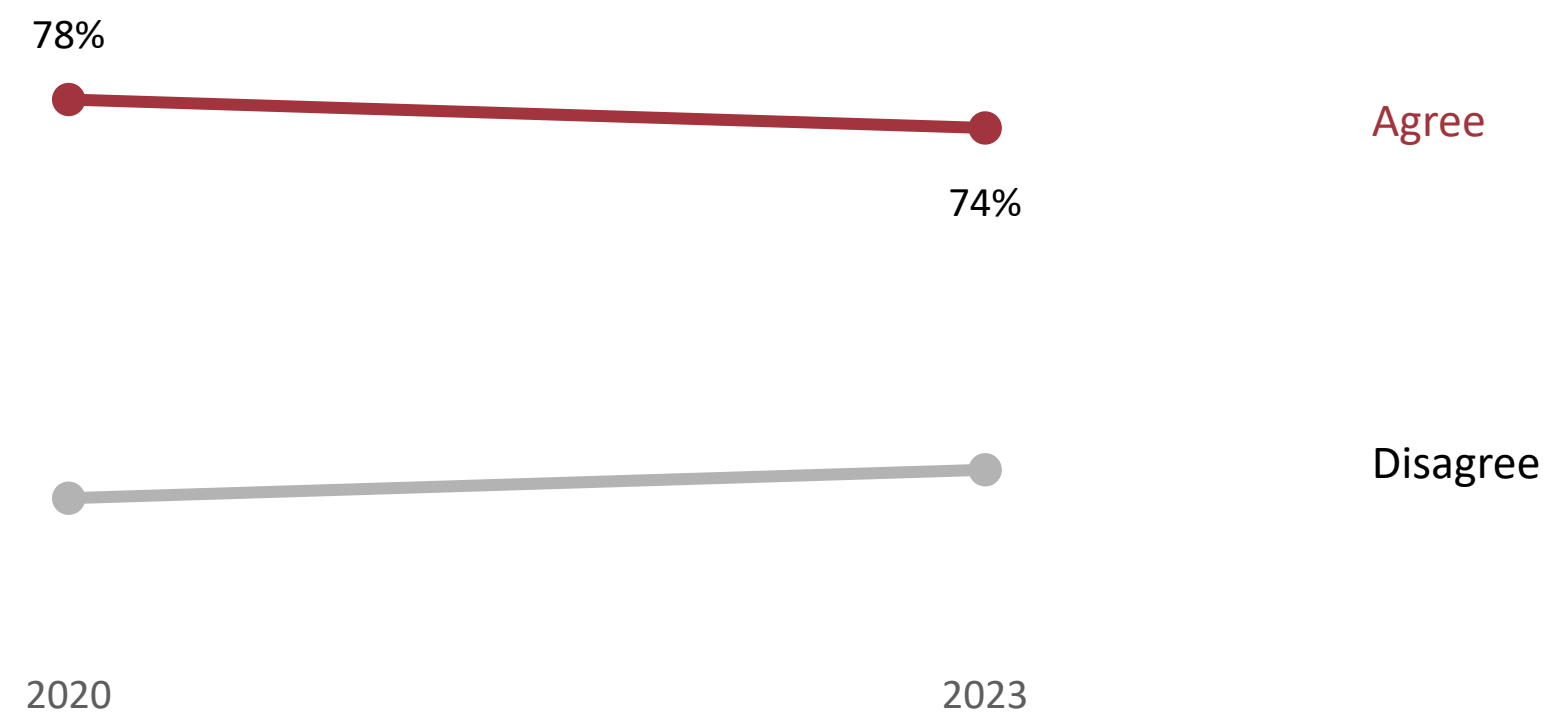

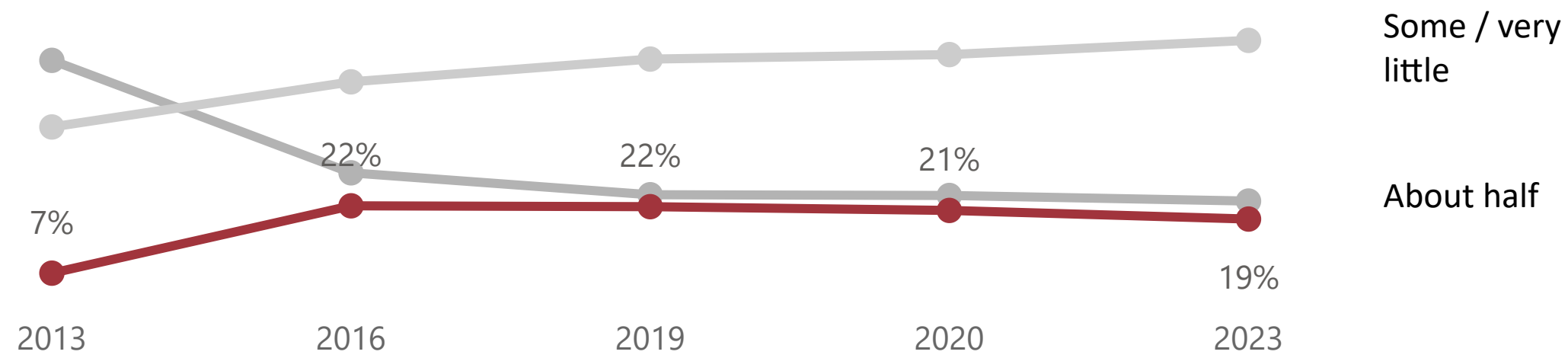

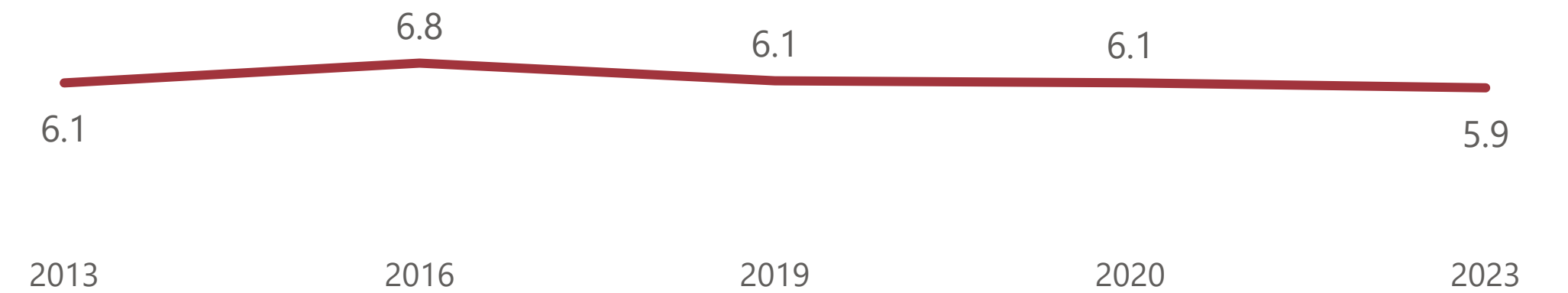
Of the time you spend preparing for class in a typical 7-day week, about how much is on assigned reading?

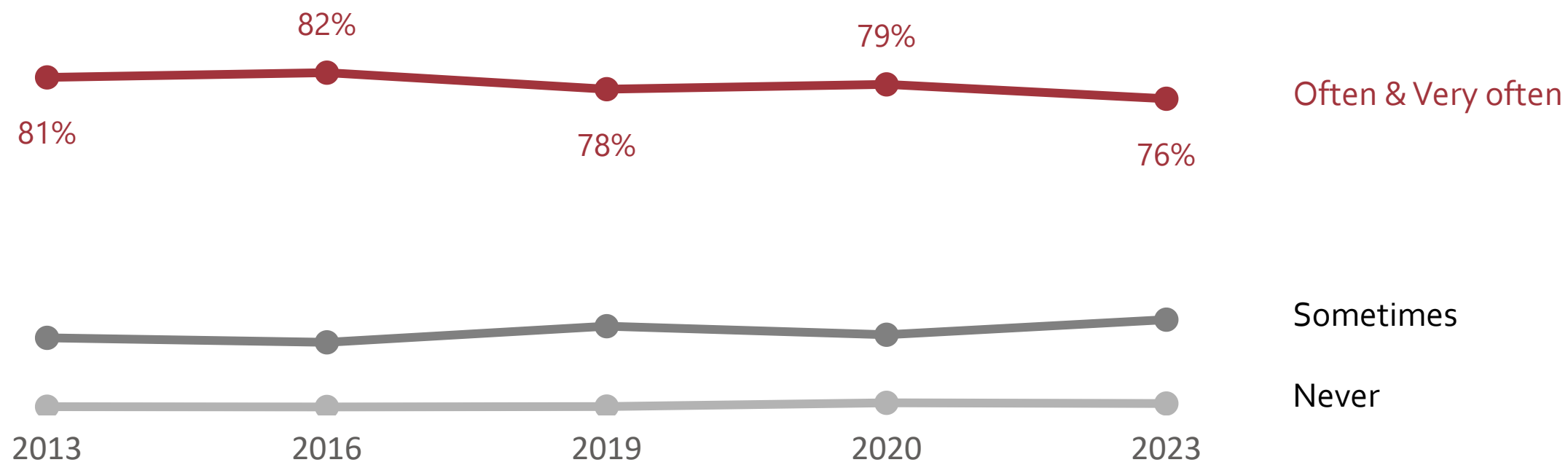
Estimated hours of assigned reading for class per week

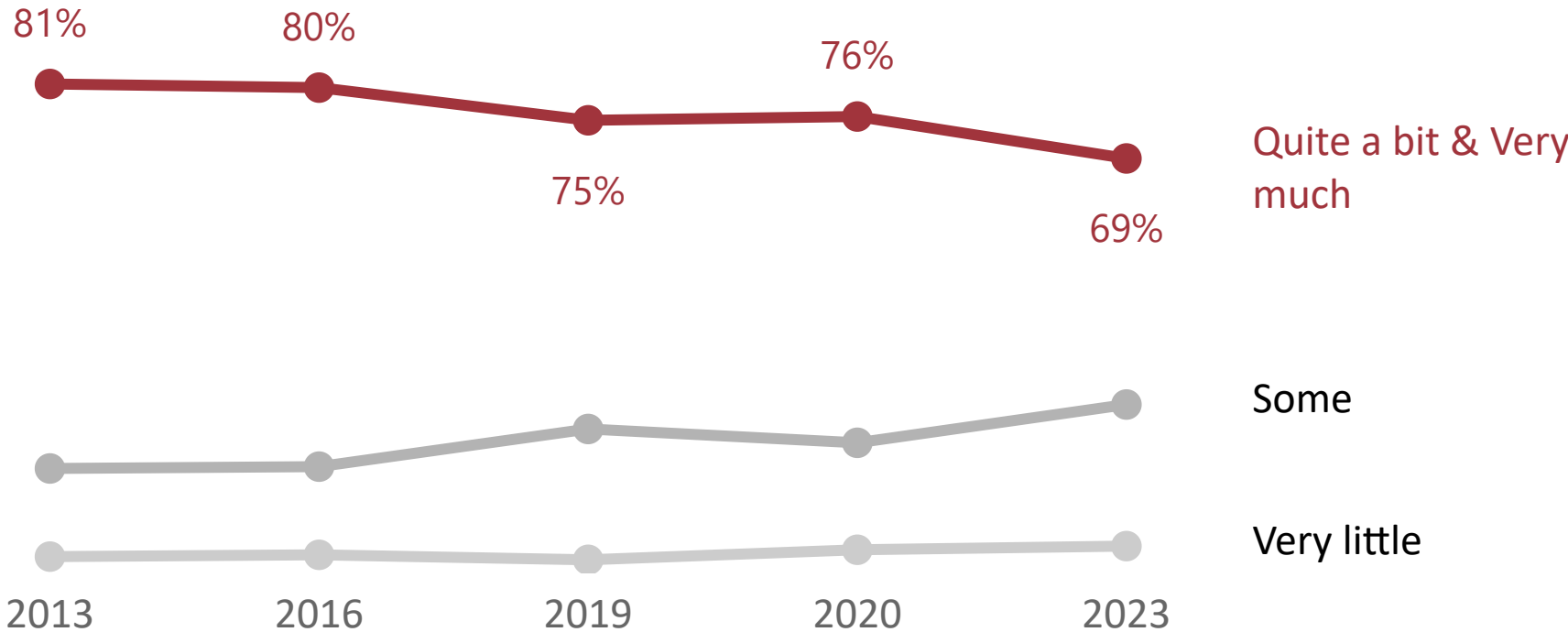

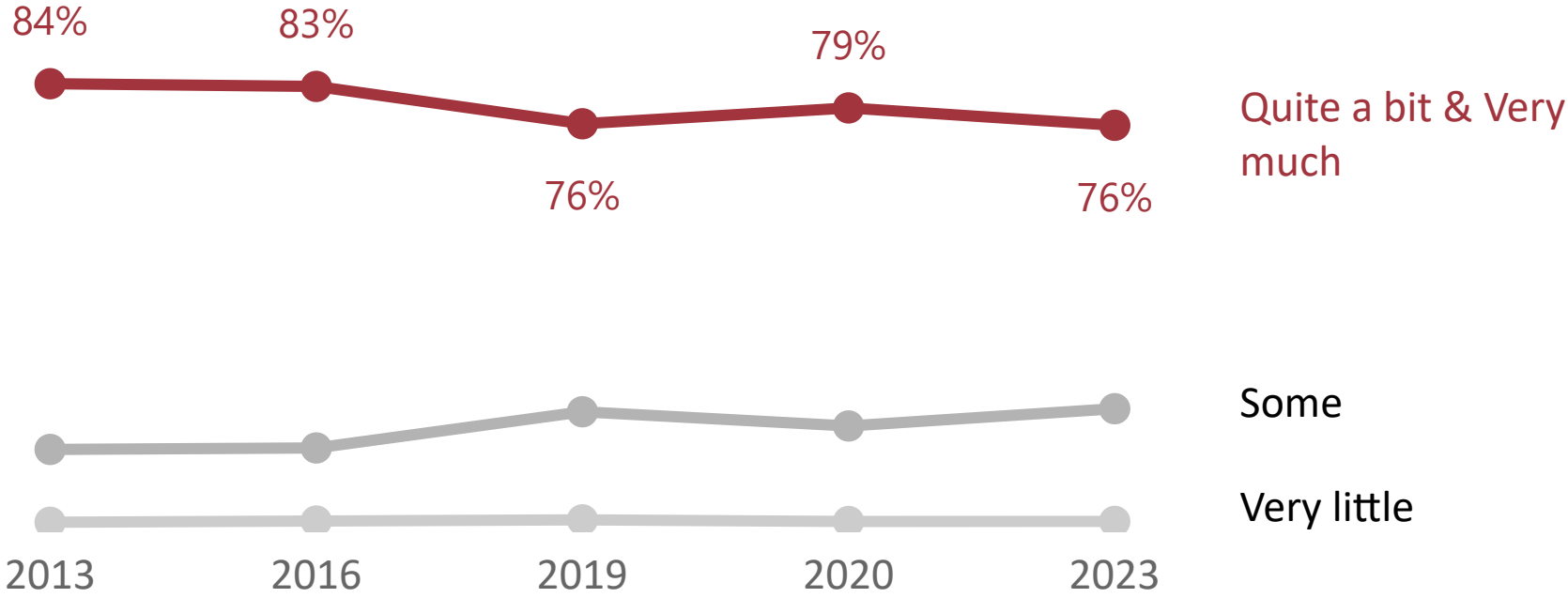

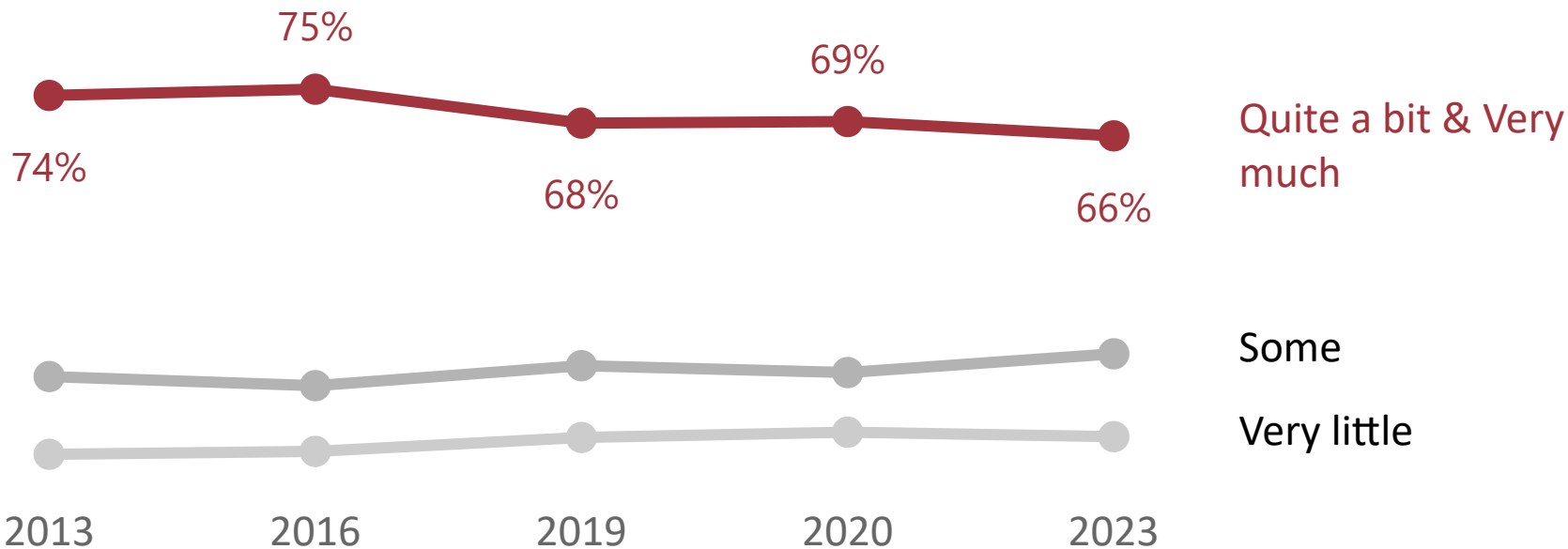

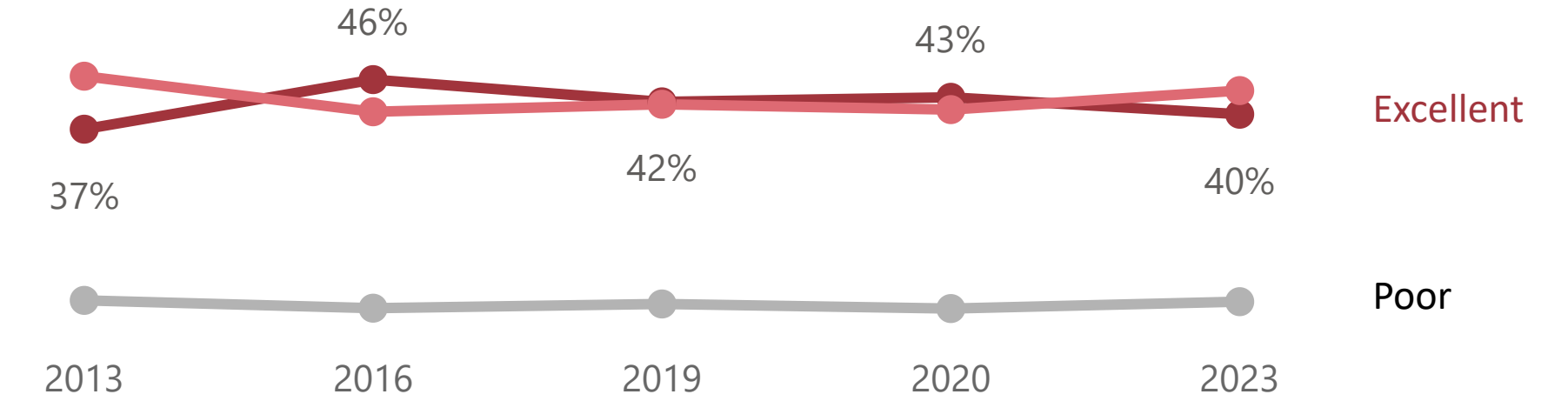

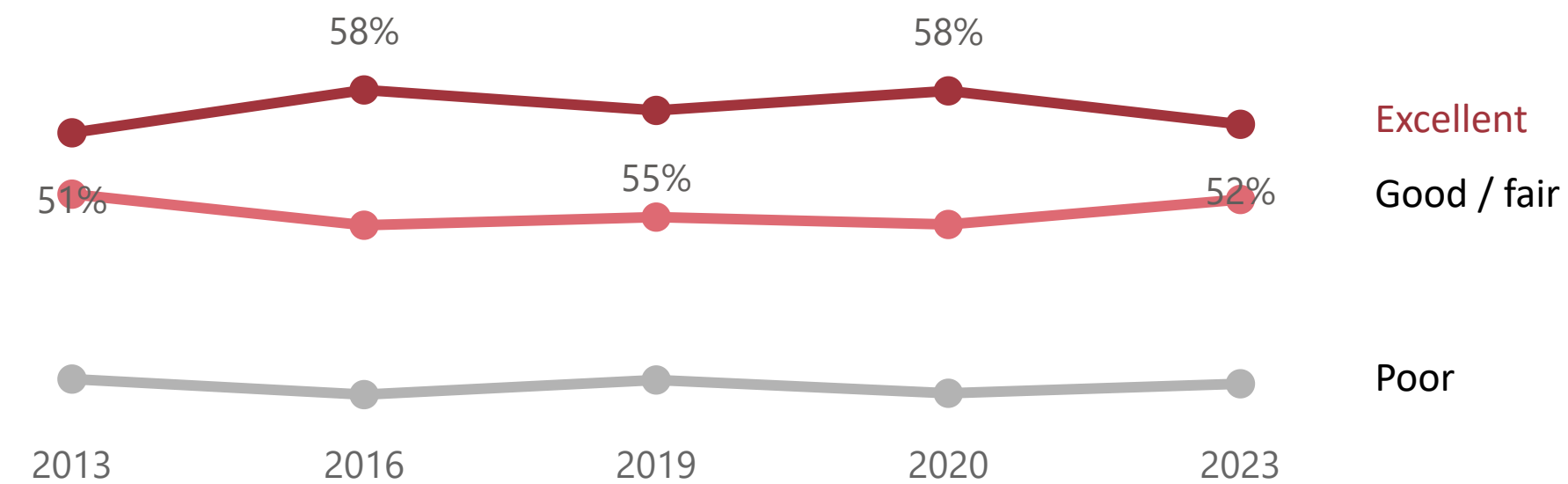
Quality of interactions with student services staff

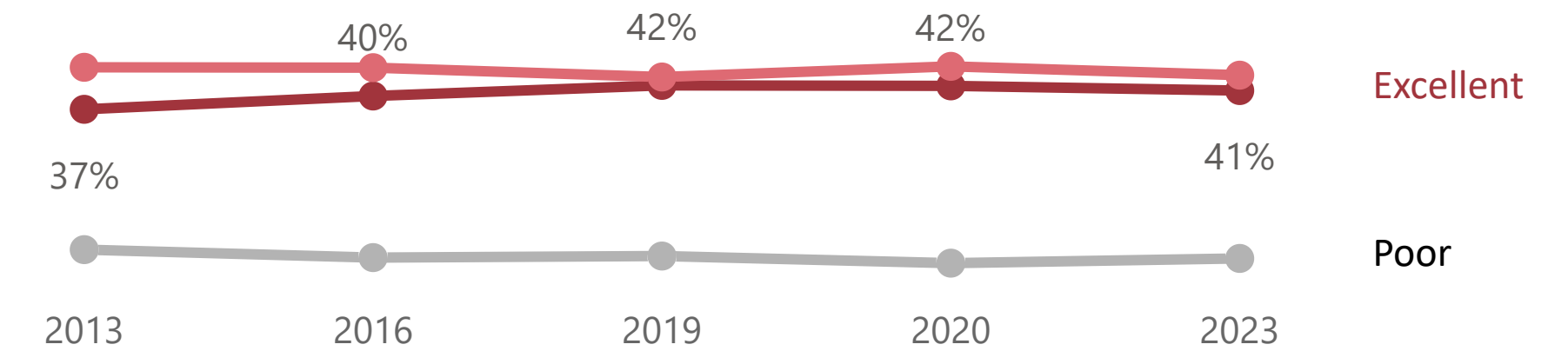

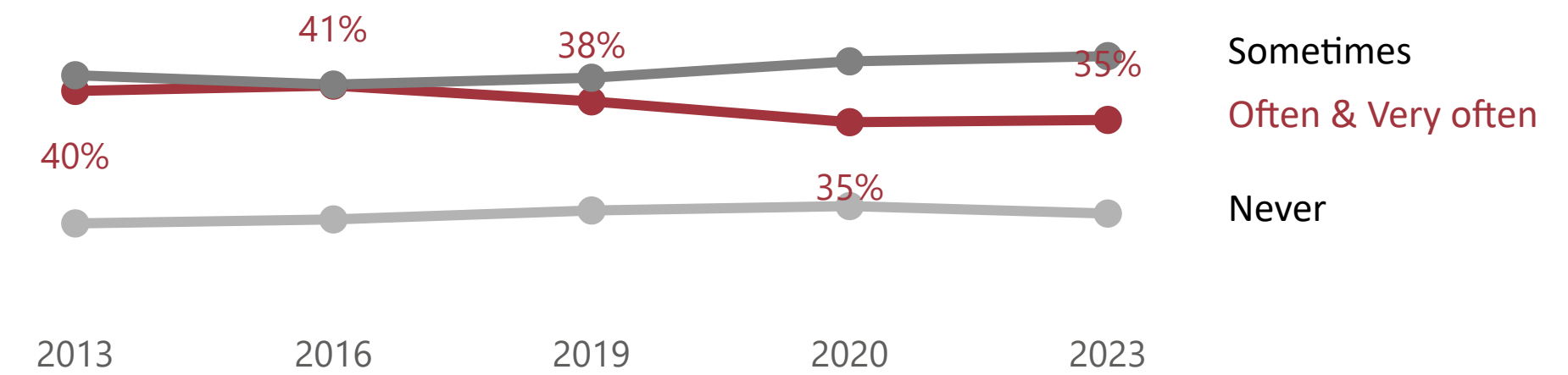

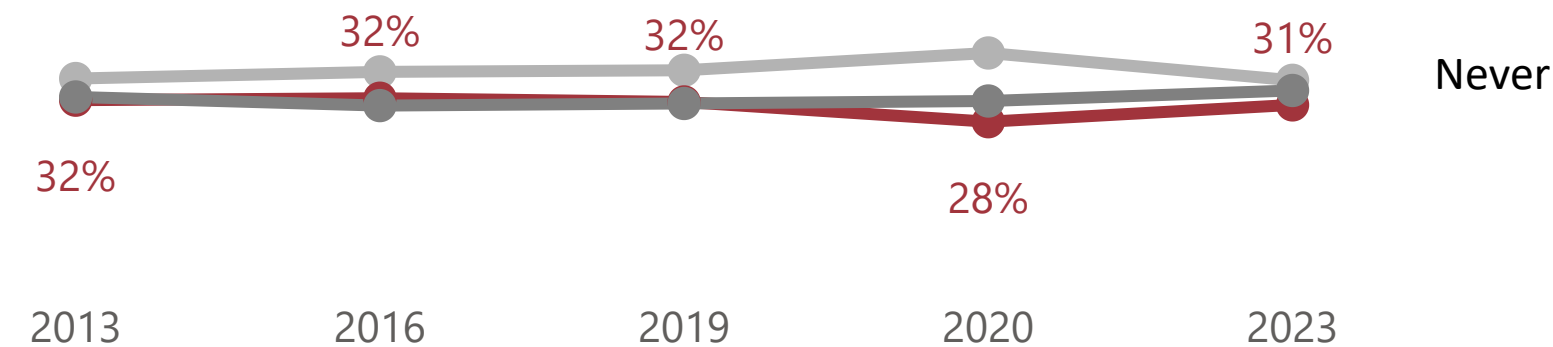

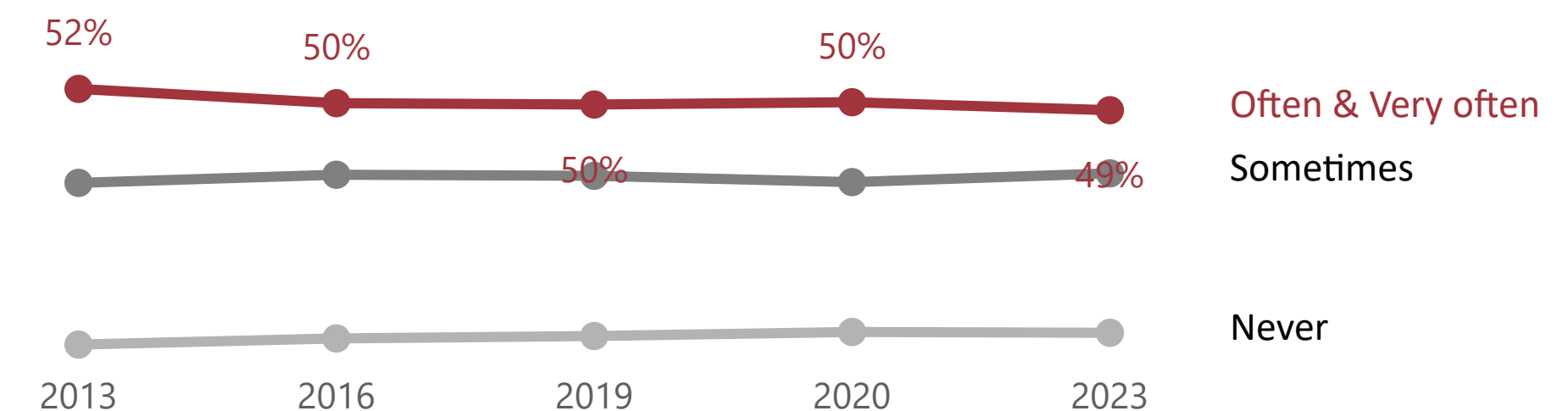

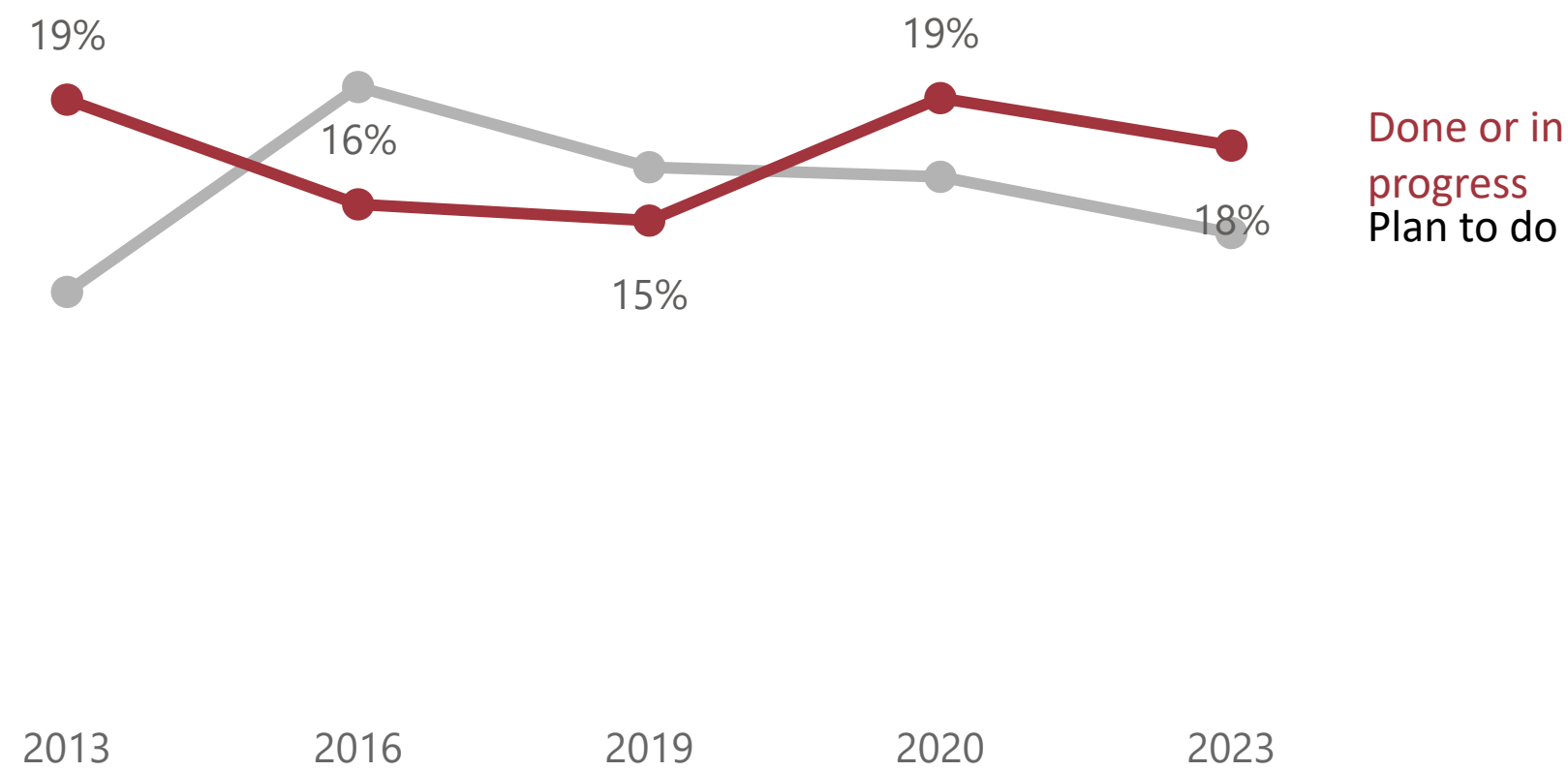

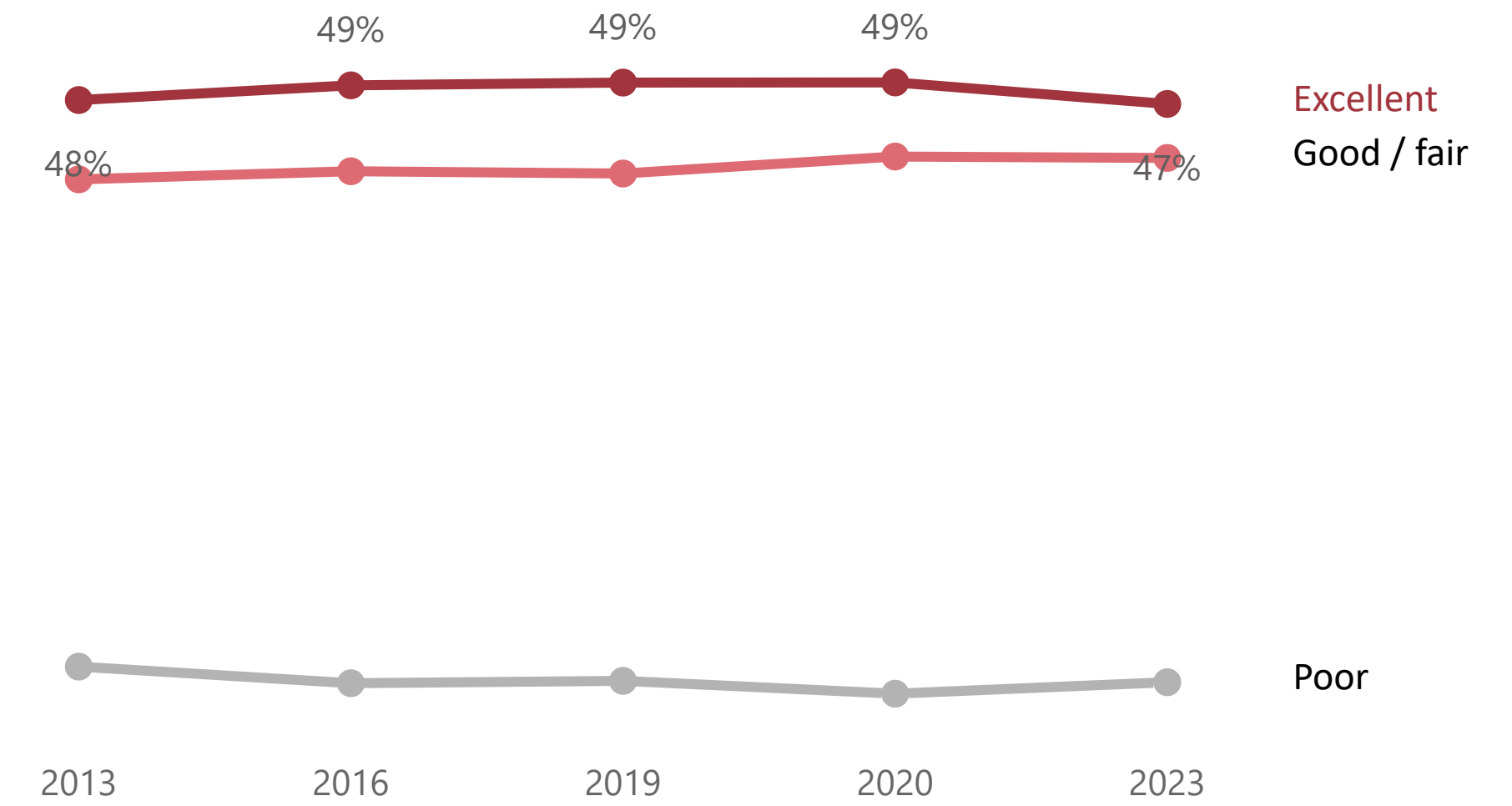

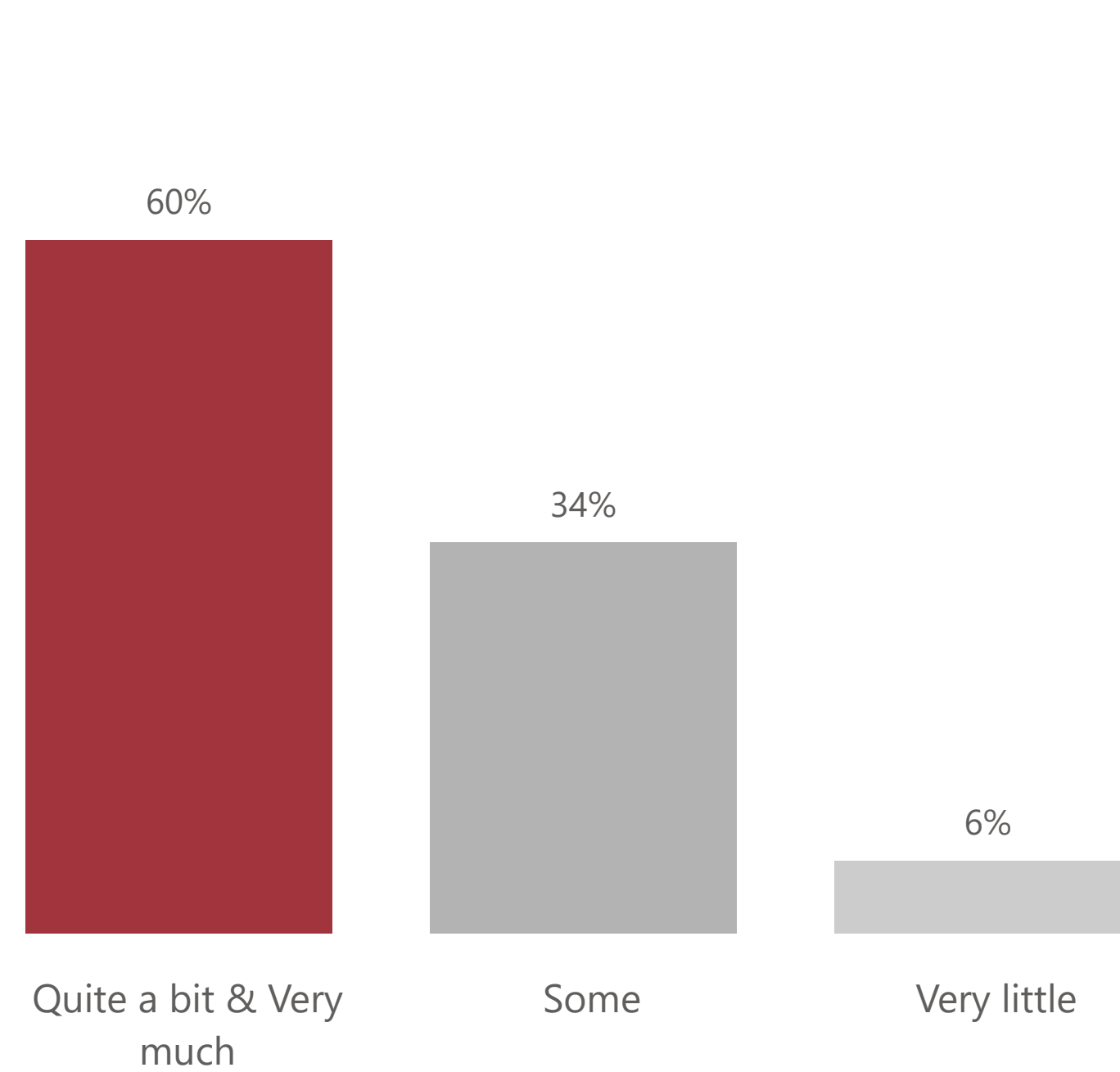

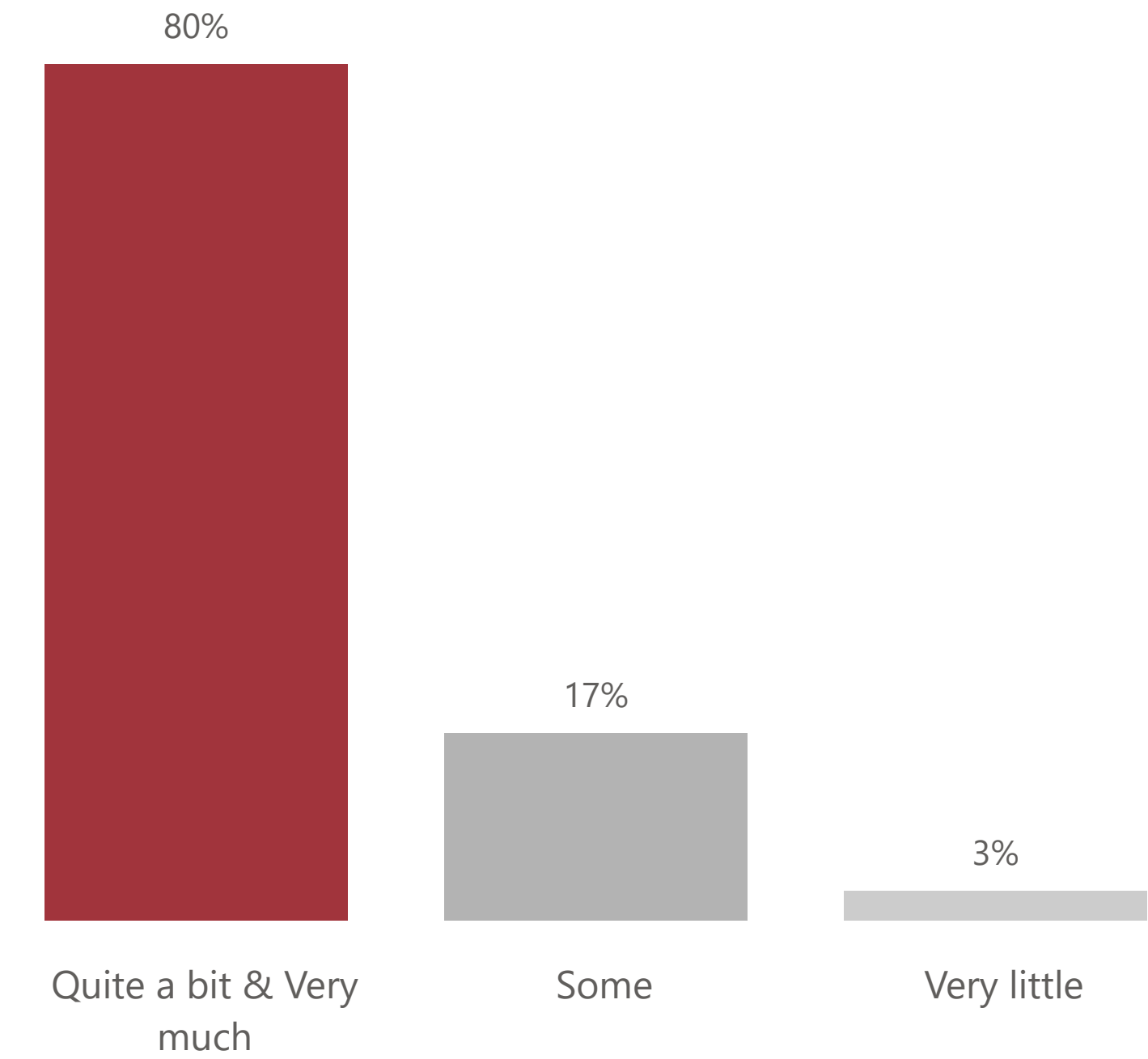

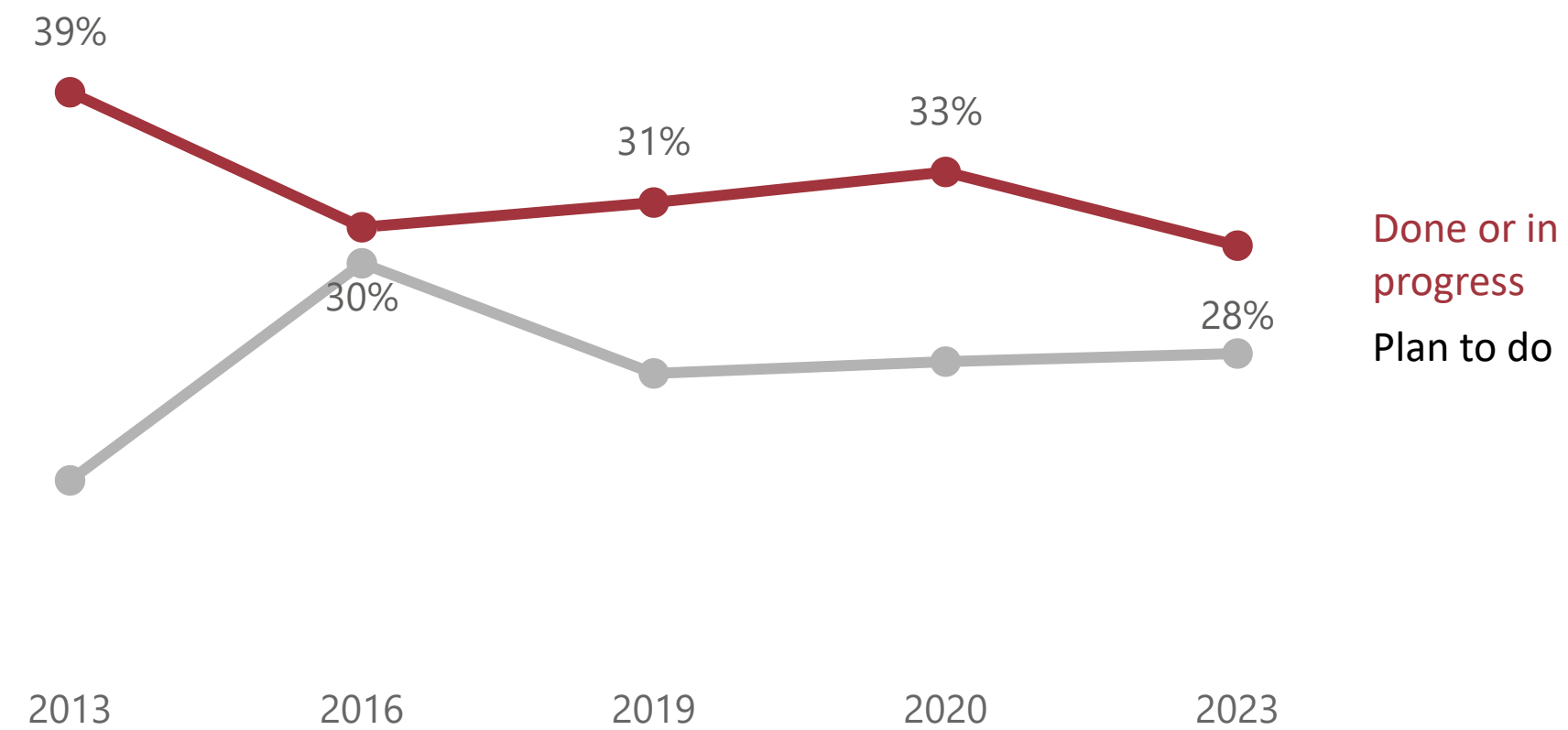

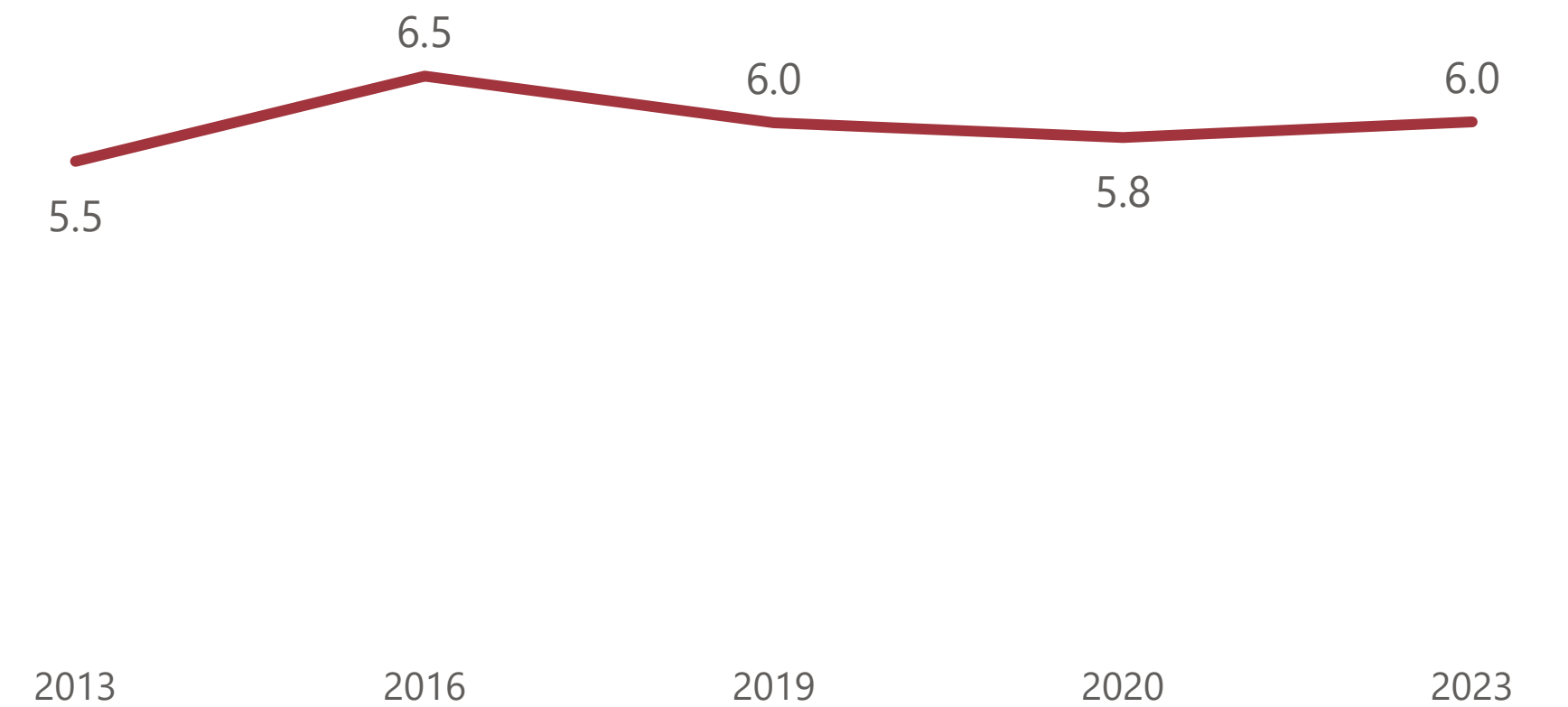

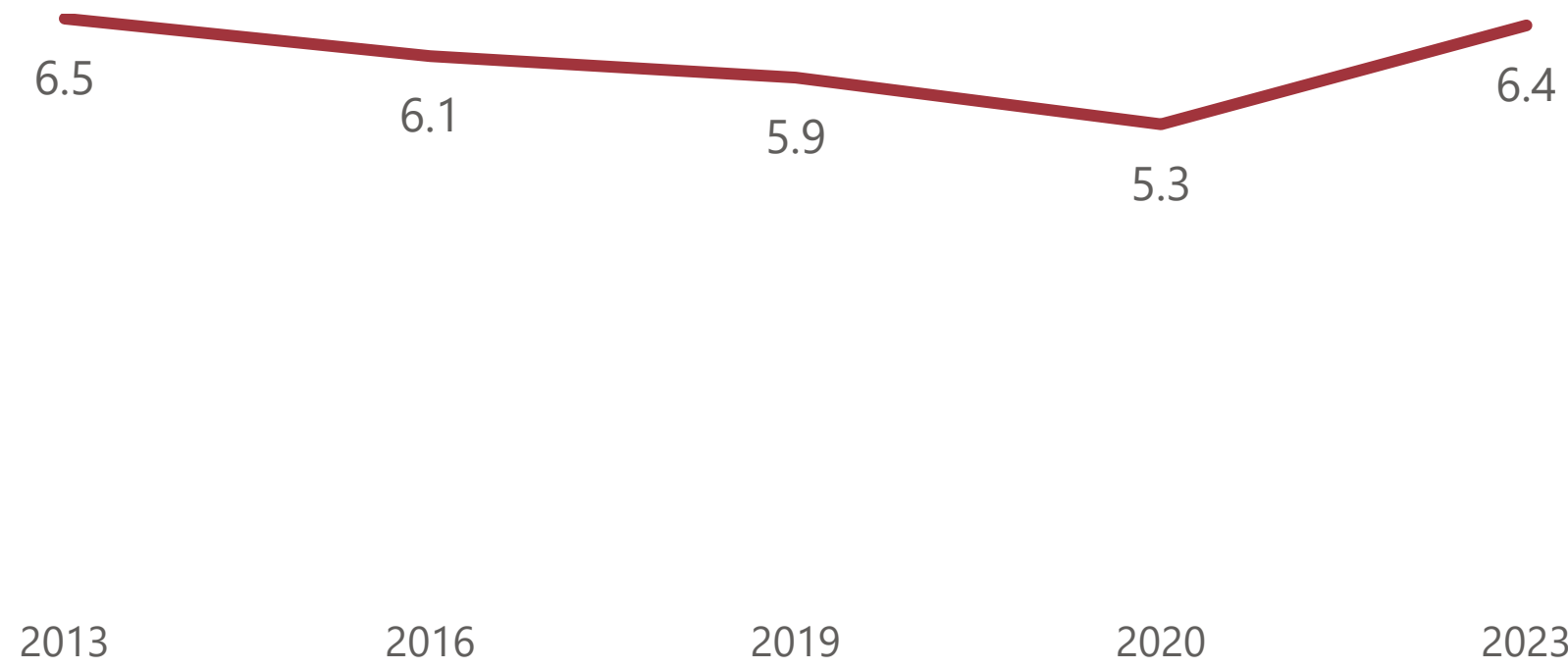

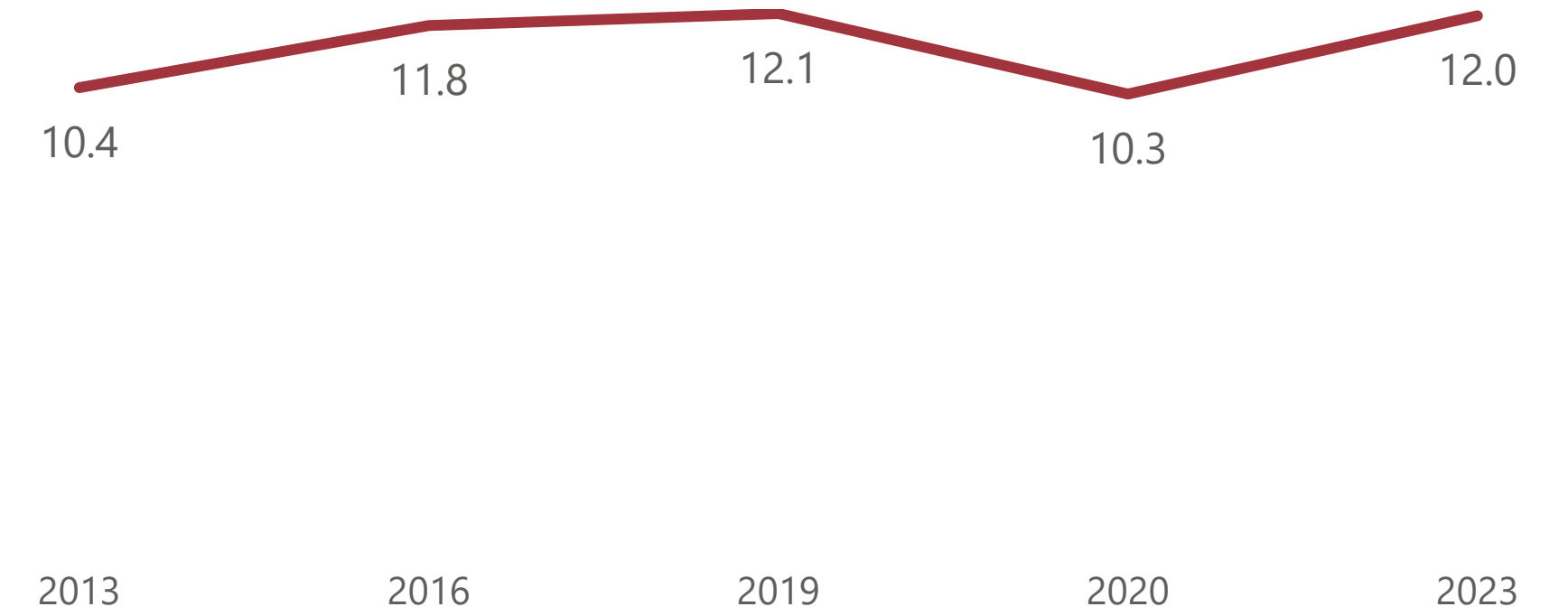

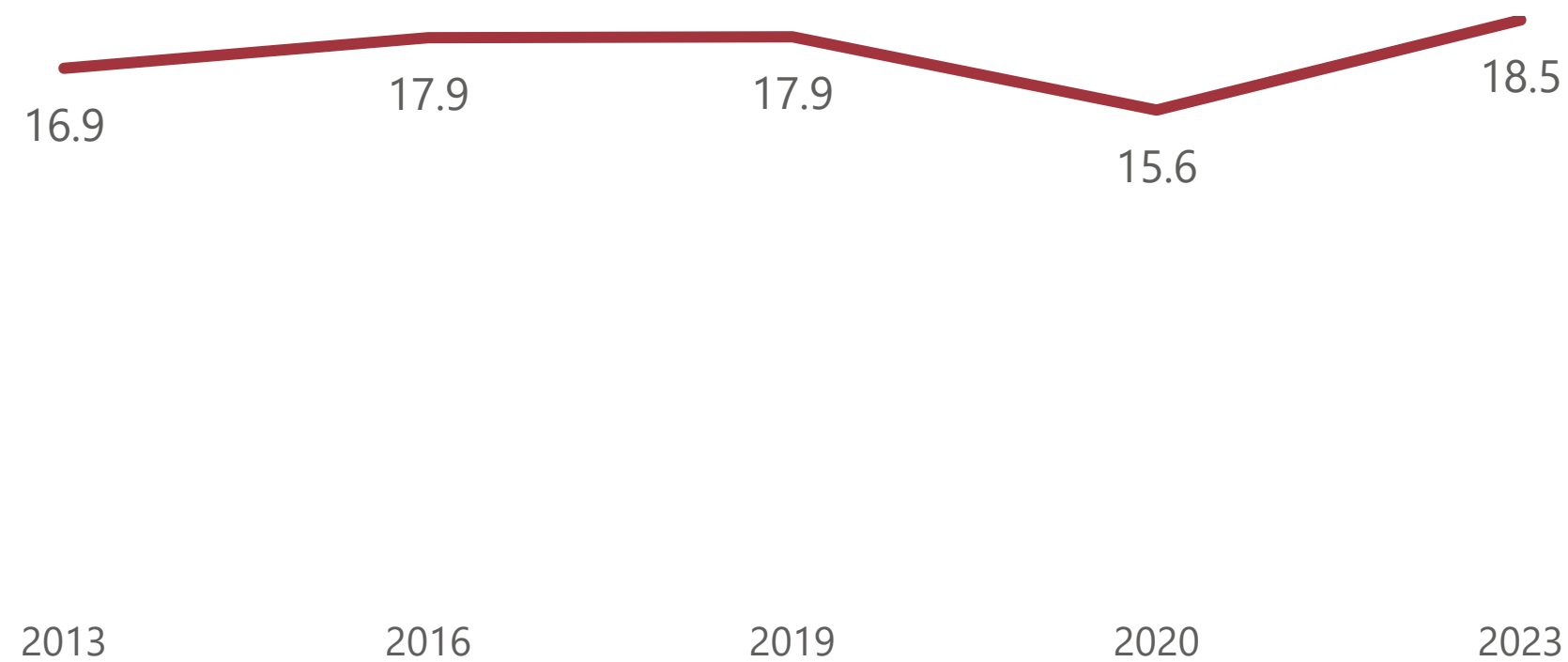
Estimated average number of hours per week working for pay OFF campus

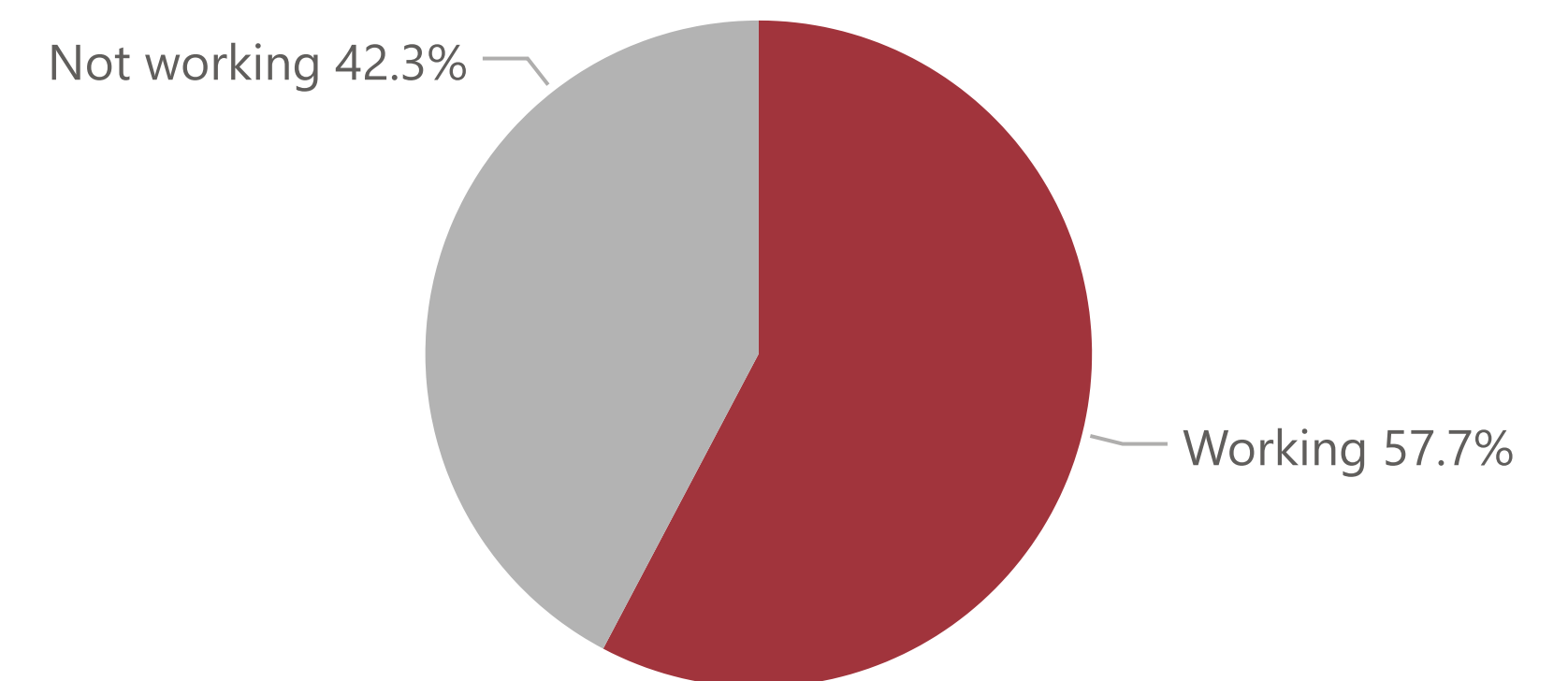


Estimated average number of hours per week working for pay: On and off campus

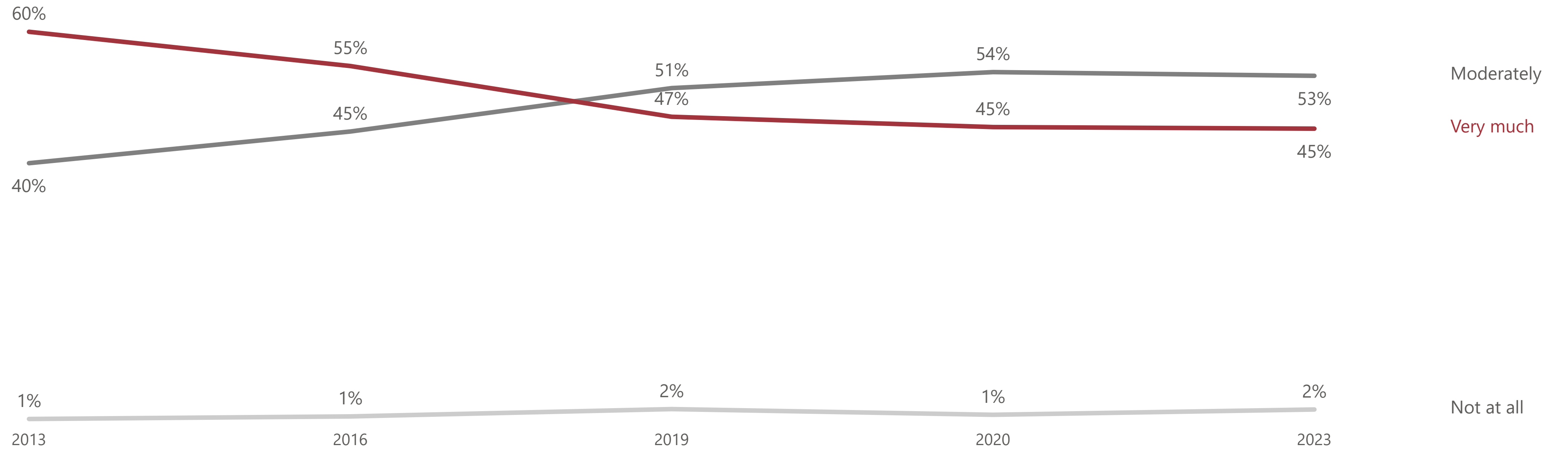

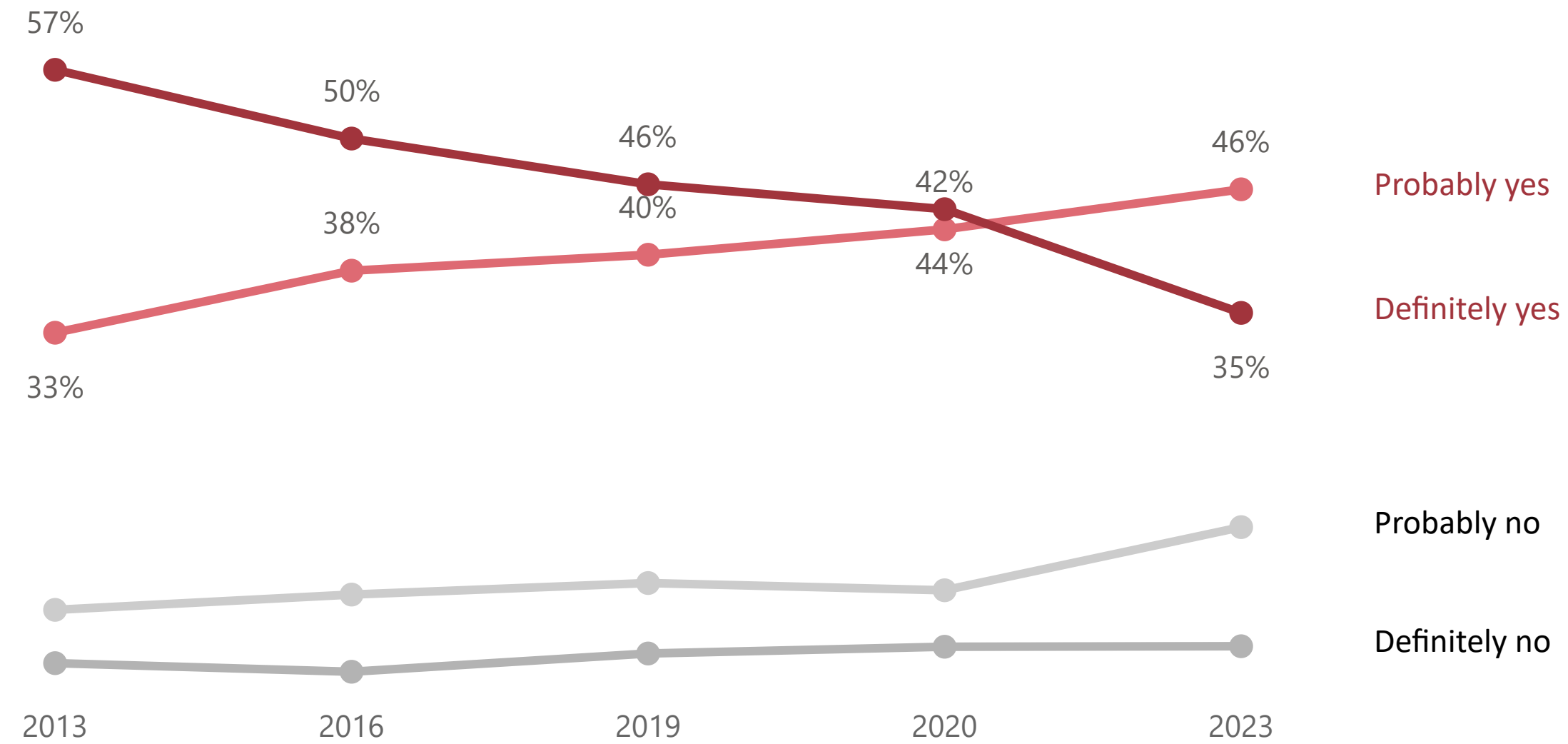


Satisfaction

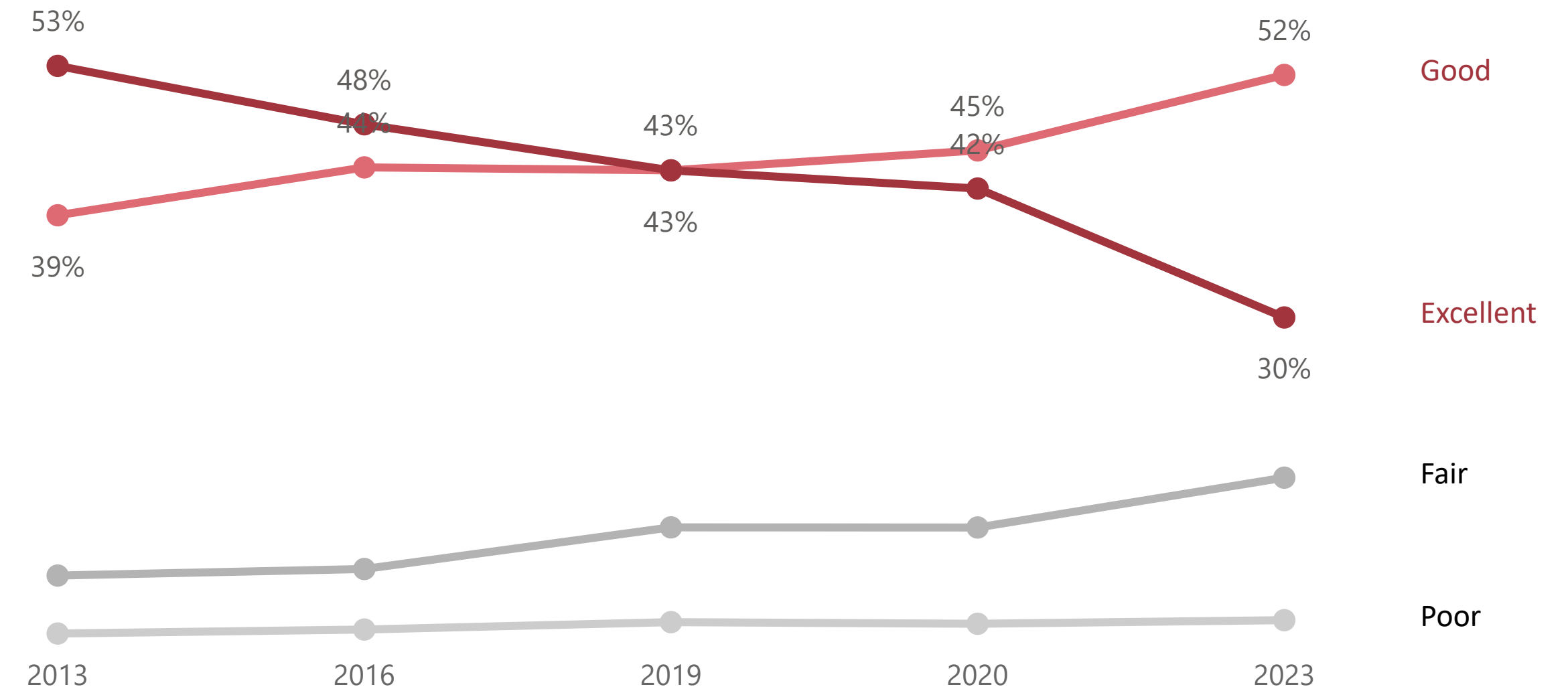
